**MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING DATE**

PECO Energy Company ("PECO"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby request a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter as follows:

1. An in person hearing for this matter is currently scheduled to take place on Friday, May 18, 2018 at 10:00 a.m.
2. The Complainant alleges in his formal complaint that he is having reliability issues at his service address, including flickering lights and brownouts on a regular basis. The Complainant additionally alleges that he has requested gas service many times and he is always rejected.
3. During a recent conversation with the Complainant, the company determined that the Complainant requires voltage monitoring to determine the cause of the flickering lights and brown outs.
4. In addition, the company has initiated a gas pilot "Good Neighbor" program to determine if the Complainant's neighbors would like to contribute towards gas service. PECO sent the letters to the Complainant's neighbors on April 17, 2018. To date, PECO has received five applications from the Complainant's neighbors, which is (7 percent) of his neighbors that are interested in gas service.


5. PECO requires additional time to obtain the results from the voltage monitor, which has been set to record for one week. In addition, PECO requires time for the neighbors to submit gas applications.

6. PECO has been in communication with the Complainant, Mark Cohen, and he has made a joint request for a continuance stating: "I was thinking that maybe we should see if we could reschedule the pre-trial hearing scheduled for May 18th for the following reasons:

1. I am not sure if a week is enough time to get a good read on the power issue from the device.
2. If another 2 weeks will give us a good status of the Residential Neighborhood Pilot Program response
3. The issue with Customer Service and power outage status information."

7. As the company and the Complainant require additional time to address the above matters and resolution of these issues may resolve Mr. Cohen's complaint, PECO and the Complainant jointly request a continuance to a further date.
