New Matter Responses – Items 10 through 19.

13: A rudimentary curb was installed by PAWC in 2011 in order to divert street water from the damaged driveway. It was unsuccessful due to the fact that that the driveway was already damaged to the point where it has been regularly pooling water for years.

14: The borough of Dunmore did install a higher curb (in 2017) which is already deteriorated to a useless state. This curb was completely unnecessary before before the initial work was done by PAWC due to the fact that all had water previously drained out into the street. I have photos from 2002 up until recent that will attest to that fact.

15-16: PAWC did send an insurance inspector many years after the driveway was sunken by years of water and mud erosion. He determined that the lack of downspout to the gutter was the problem. Completely neglecting that, whether or not there was a downspout, all water from the gutter drains to the same place that had previously drained into the street. He also neglected that the area where PAWC initially dug up the driveway is a very ugly patch, where in the middle is a shut off valve access that is inches lower then the street and other parts of the driveway.


17: I don't know of any violations - I'm not a lawyer. (I do know that the PAWC has just informed me that it's OK to stop boiling my water . . . Without ever telling me to do so in the first place). But that's a later issue they may have to contend with.

18: I have been complaining to the PAWC every other year since the problem started. If they want to site statutes of limitation, it should be from the date of my latest complaint (Or even the date of my previous complaint which is also under 3 years ago).

Request For Relief:

I will stand behind my original claim that I've been asking since the beginning. To have my driveway restored to it's original state where: 1) It was all level. 2) It was high enough to drain water into the street. 3) there is no ugly, uneven asphalt patch over the dig area. (All one needs to do is have a look at the original disfigured patch and water valve access that was installed by the PAWC in order to determine what happened) I can supply photos upon request.

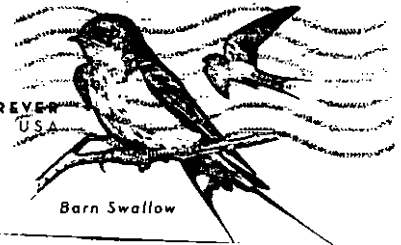

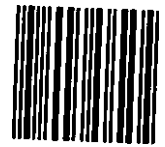
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
