Motion to Extend the Due Date for the Reply Brief

Your Honor,

John Kline respectfully requests that the time to file the Reply Brief in the above-captioned matter, which is currently set to be due on June 1st 2018, be extended until at least December 1st 2018.

After reviewing PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's 68 page main brief it has become apparent that the reply brief will require much more preparation and research that cannot be completed by the current due date. Significant work is needed to review and answer all of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's claims and to review all of the Pennsylvania Court Decisions and Pennsylvania Administrative Agency Decisions referenced in their main brief. We do not have the financial resources to hire a lawyer to defend our rights and also do not have the financial

resources to purchase the transcript of the hearing. To properly file the reply multiple days will have to be spent at the PUC Secretaries Bureau to once again review the transcript.

In order to accomplish this I would have to take additional time off from work, since my work day normally starts around 7:30 am and ends around 6:00 pm and I cannot visit the PUC Secretaries Bureau during their regular hours, it would be an unwarranted burden to get this accomplished. During these proceedings I have already taken a total of 3 weeks vacation time in 2018 to complete research, prepare for the hearing, attend the hearing, visit the Secretaries Bureau to prepare for the main brief and complete the brief. This does not include the time I also took off from work in 2017. I am now in my busy season and cannot get any additional time off until the fall of 2018.

In addition, my family and I are going through other personal, financial and confidential disruptions that would prevent me from spending the time needed to properly answer PPL Electric Utilities Corporation's 68 page main brief by the current due date of June 1st 2018.

By making this request I understand that PPL Electric Utilities Corporation would also have an extended time to file their reply brief which I have no objection to.

I am also copying in Mr. Devin T. Ryan, Council for PPL Electric Utilities Corporation, to make him aware of my request.
