Re: Agreement dated April 27, 2018 between the Borough of Dunmore and Pennsylvania-American Water Company (the "Company") for Street Sweeping and Inlet Cleaning Services

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On December 7, 2017, the Commission entered an Order at Docket No. R-2017-2595853, wherein the Joint Petition for Settlement of Rate Investigation (the "Settlement") was approved and adopted without modification. According to the Settlement dated and filed with the Commission on October 16, 2017, specifically, Heading **II. Terms and Conditions**, Section **G. Street Sweeping Within The City of Scranton and The Borough of Dunmore**, Paragraphs **29-31**, the Company agreed to enter into an agreement with the City of Scranton and the Borough of Dunmore (the "Municipalities") to memorialize its existing cooperative arrangement with the Municipalities wherein the Company agreed to: 1) have regular periodic meetings with the Municipalities; 2) discuss, at such meetings, and provide input regarding the Municipalities' street sweeping schedules, identify priority areas for street sweeping and also identify areas that need additional street sweeping by the Municipalities; and 3) be responsible for cleaning out catch basins that are within the combined sewer system to remove grit and other material.


The Company is filing for approval under Section 507 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 507, the attached Agreement for Street Sweeping and Inlet Cleaning Services between the Borough of Dunmore and the Company ("Agreement"), which meets the foregoing criteria.

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A copy of the Agreement has also been served upon each of the parties listed on the attached Certificate of Service.

**Agreement for Street Sweeping and Inlet Cleaning Services
between
The Borough of Dunmore
and
Pennsylvania-American Water Company (PAWC)**

This Agreement for Street Sweeping and Inlet Cleaning Services (this "Agreement"), is made this 27th day of April, 2018, (the "Effective Date"), by and between The Borough of Dunmore, a Pennsylvania Municipality, having an address of 400 South Blakely St., Dunmore, Pennsylvania (hereinafter referred to as "Borough") and Pennsylvania-American Water Company, a Pennsylvania corporation, having a mailing address of 800 West Hersheypark Drive, Hershey, PA 17033 (hereinafter referred to as "PAWC").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the purpose of this agreement is to memorialize the current responsibilities of the signatory parties associated with street sweeping services and other stormwater inlet/catch basin related cleaning and maintenance activities associated with the combined sewer system within the wastewater service territory of PAWC's Scranton wastewater operations.

WHEREAS, the responsibilities listed below are consistent with PAWC's Nine Minimum Control Plan associated with its combined sewer system and the Borough's obligation associated with its MS4 stormwater system.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants expressed in this Agreement and for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound hereby, the parties agree as follows:

1. The parties agree to meet periodically (frequency may vary from monthly to quarterly) to coordinate activities outlined in this Agreement and discuss opportunities to collaboratively improve operations.

2. The Borough agrees to continue to provide street sweeping activities for municipal roadways within the wastewater service territory of PAWC's Scranton wastewater operations. Schedules for such operations will be provided to PAWC and posted for public use.
3. PAWC agrees to continue to perform cleaning of storm drainage inlets and catch basins associated with PAWC's combined sewer system to remove grit and other material. PAWC plans to mark select storm drainage inlets with plaques or other markings to inform the public and differentiate these inlets from stormwater only (MS4) inlets which are owned and maintained by the Borough.
4. Methods and procedures associated with the party's respective responsibilities shall be consistent with industry standards. Neither party shall charge the other signatories for the responsibilities outlined herein.
5. The term of this Agreement shall continue until such time as either party provides notice within 90 days to the other signatories to this Agreement.
6. This Agreement is subject to the approval of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, which approval shall be in form and substance reasonably satisfactory to PAWC.
