
Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On behalf of Rasier-PA LLC ("Rasier"), enclosed is a check for fifty dollars (\$50.00). This is the fine amount requested by the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement to terminate further proceedings in connection with the above-captioned Complaint ("Complaint"). The Complaint alleges that Rasier is subject to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("PaPUC") jurisdiction pursuant to a certificate of public convenience granted to Rasier at Docket No. A-2014-2416127 on August 21, 2014, authorizing the transportation of persons in experimental service. In addition, the Complaint alleges that Rasier is in violation of Section 29.71 of the Commission's regulations, 52 Pa. Code § 29.71, governing the marking of vehicles used in common carrier service.

Rasier denies that it operates as a common carrier pursuant to an authorization to provide experimental service in Pennsylvania and that it is subject to the Commission's common carrier regulations. Rasier is a Transportation Network Company operating in Pennsylvania pursuant to a license issued by this Commission under Chapter 26 of the Public Utility Code. Nevertheless, Rasier does not contest payment of the requested fine and is forwarding this amount in order to resolve and close this Complaint.
