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**JOINT STATUS REPORT RE SETTLEMENT DISCUSSIONS**

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Settlement discussions are continuing in the consolidated proceedings at the above dockets. Due to scheduling conflicts which arose following issuance of the Interim Order Granting a Further Continuance, the parties were unable to convene a formal settlement conference on May 16, 2018. Instead, counsel for the City of Reading ("City") circulated a seven page document on May 17, 2018 providing the City's "thoughts" for settlement and a comparison of the relief requested in the Complaint with modifications the City was prepared to make in settlement.


After an opportunity for review by UGI, counsel then exchanged emails on Friday, May 18, 2018, addressing settlement proposals and scheduling an in-depth telephonic settlement conference for Monday, May 21, 2018. Internal discussions were also held by the City with substantive decision-makers to address several matters before the conference call.

The conference call was then held on Monday afternoon, May 21, 2018, with the City's attorneys, UGI's attorneys, and two technical representatives from UGI participating. The discussions were productive and substantive, and included ideas for settlement of a related

Commonwealth Court proceeding involving City ordinances. It is the belief of counsel that progress was made toward settlement. The City is addressing points raised by UGI and UGI is doing the same with respect to matters raised by the City. The City will try to schedule another in-depth conference call with counsel for UGI following the submission of this Status Report and prior to the Memorial Day holiday.

In conclusion, it is counsels' belief that a settlement is possible which would include the related Commonwealth Court proceeding, as well as the above complaint proceeding.
