Please be advised to the best of my knowledge and belief that all sanitary sewer lines identified in the current Township's Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan have been completed and that the Township is in compliance with that document.

Also public water service within the Township is provided by the Pennsylvania American Water Company. Areas outside the public water service area utilize private wells.

With regards to the Proposed Service Territory, Map Area 3 and Area 4 are consistent with the current Act 537 Plan which includes supplemental planning approval by PaDEP.

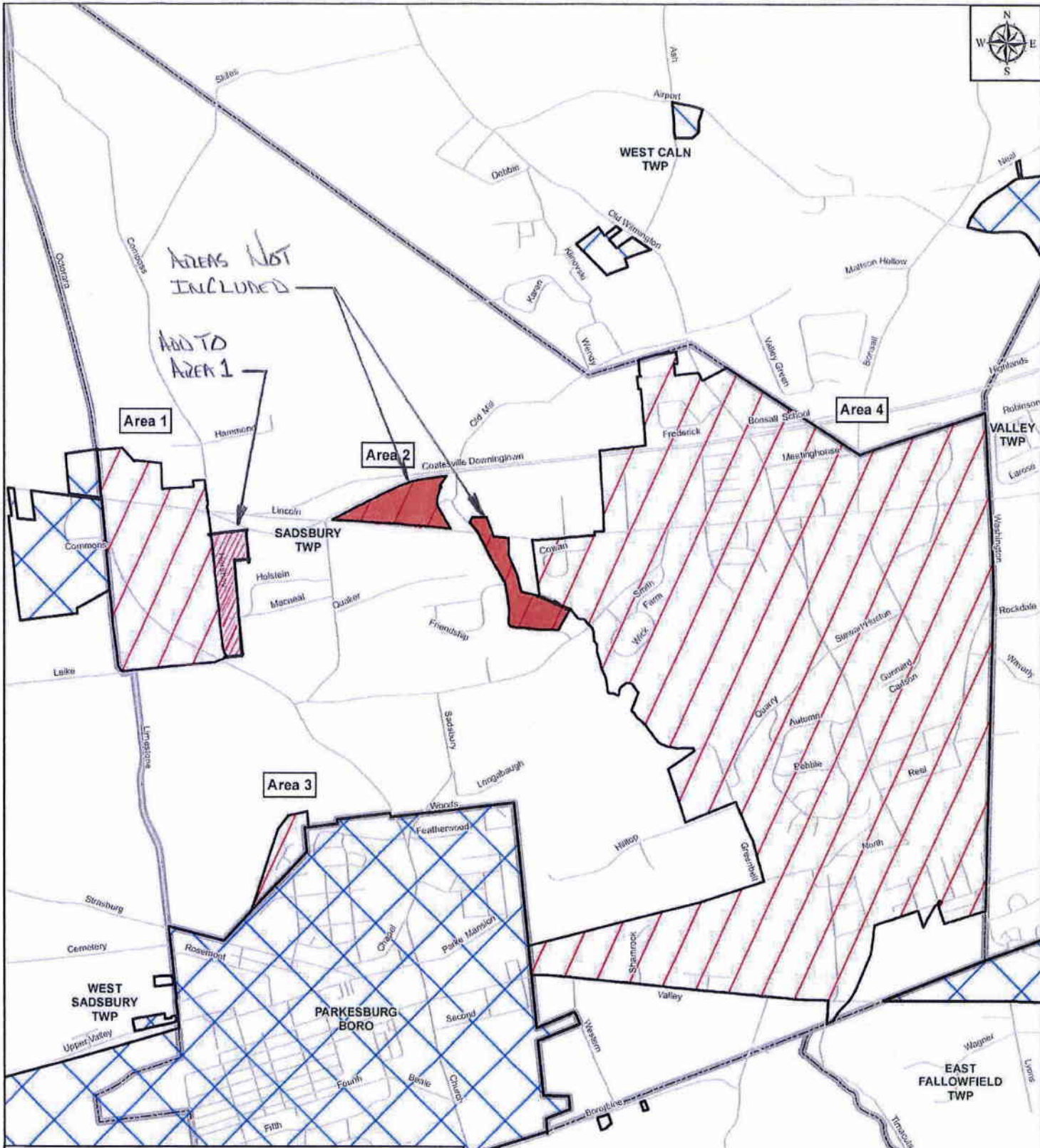
Area 1 represents what has been referred to as the Western Sewer District, which has been recognized by the Township. The Planning Module for this area has been submitted and reviewed by PaDEP, and is currently being revised to address PaDEP's outstanding issues.

Area 2 and the area directly to the Southeast therefrom are additional service areas recognized by the Township subject to future planning.

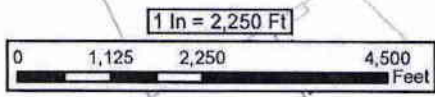


Pennsylvania-American Water Company
