- This tariff contains clarifications to the rules and regulations set forth on Trust Ambulance, Inc.'s previous tariff, omission of payment rule and a change in the rate.

Operating Authority

Certificate No. A-2009-2110951

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in paratransit service, from points in the city of Harrisburg, Dauphin County, and within an airline distance of forty (40) statute miles of the limits of said city, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

Certificate No. A-2009-2145264

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in paratransit service, from points in they city of Harrisburg, Dauphin County, and within an airline distance of forty (40) statute miles of the limits of said city, to points in Pennsylvania, and return: SO AS TO PERMIT the transportation of persons, in paratransit service from points in the county of York and the borough of Chambersburg, Franklin County, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

Certificate No. A-2013-2369944

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in paratransit service from points east of the Counties of Franklin, Juniata, Mifflin, Union, Northumberland, Montour, Columbia, Luzerne, Wyoming and Susquehanna and return but not within the aforementioned counties except as otherwise authorized by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission;

Provided that Trust Ambulance, Inc. has no right, power or privilege to originate paratransit service in the Counties of Chester, Wayne, Lackawanna and Monroe and no right, power or privilege to originate paratransit service in the County of Snyder beyond the authority already granted by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission at A-2009-2110951

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. *ADVANCED RESERVATION:*

(C) Advanced reservations for service must be made no later than 15 minutes prior to service being rendered.

2. *MILEAGE:*

- Rates for mileage are determined by the odometer of the vehicle in use and begin when the vehicle is loaded (i.e. the passenger is on board) and departs the origination point (i.e. passenger's home, facility or other departure point). The final round trip mileage reading is determined upon return to the origination point from the destination.

3. *SERVICE:*

- Service is provided in wheelchair capable vans on a non-exclusive basis.

4. *HOURS OF SERVICE:*

(C) All trips can be scheduled at any time during the day.

- Operation hours are 24 hours per day, seven days per week.

5. *WAITING TIME:*

- Waiting time is charged pursuant to the schedule of rates for all time the wheelchair van personnel must wait for the passenger at the origination point or at the destination.

SCHEDULE OF RATES
(Per Person)

FLAT RATES:

(R) Wheelchair van base rate: \$40.00 one way

MILEAGE RATES:

(R) Mileage rates apply in addition to the flat rates stated above on all loaded miles from the point of pick-up to the point of destination.

(R) Wheelchair van: \$2.50 per mile or fraction thereof

WAITING TIME:

During which the van personnel must wait for the passenger at the point of pick up or delivery shall be charged at the rate of:

(R) Wheelchair Van \$1.00 per minute or fraction thereof.
