PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or the “Company”) respectfully requests that the evidentiary hearing in the above-captioned matter, which is currently set to be held on August 28, 2018, be rescheduled for October 12, 2018. The Company’s witnesses are no longer available for the hearing on August 28, 2018.

Pursuant to your Prehearing Order dated April 5, 2018, I sent a letter to Mr. and Mrs. Bamberger on June 1, 2018, requesting that the hearing be rescheduled and providing a list of dates when PPL Electric may be available for the rescheduled hearing. On June 8, 2018, Mrs. Bamberger and I spoke on the phone about the request. On June 11, 2018, Mrs. Bamberger sent me an email indicating that she would be amenable to rescheduling the hearing for dates in October 2018. After exchanging further email correspondence, the parties determined that a hearing on October 12, 2018, would work best. I have confirmed that all of PPL Electric’s witnesses have made themselves available for a hearing on October 12, 2018.

In addition, PPL Electric respectfully requests that any due dates for the exchange or submission of exhibits, reports, and statements, which were set forth in the April 5, 2018 Prehearing Order, be adjusted to reflect the new hearing date. Accordingly, PPL Electric respectfully proposes the following:




