
COMPLAINT

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth. The Commission has delegated its authority to initiate proceedings which are prosecutory in nature to the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and other bureaus with enforcement responsibilities. Pursuant to that delegated authority and Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement Prosecutory Staff hereby represents as follows:

1. That Parrish Transportation, Inc., Respondent, maintains a principal place of business at 1095 Pittston Bypass, Jenkins Township, Pennsylvania, 18640.
2. That Respondent was issued a certificate of public convenience by this Commission on May 2, 1932, at Application Docket No. A-00022037 authorizing transportation of household goods authority.
3. That on May 4, 2018, Respondent permitted a 2007 Ford Limousine bearing license number LM26417 and having Vehicle Identification No. 1L1FM88W87Y632906 to be operated by driver Stanley Rovinski, Jr. That on that date, Motor Carrier Enforcement Manager Andrew Turriziani performed an inspection on the referenced vehicle. The driver was found to be not wearing corrective lenses as required by his current Medical Examiner's Certificate.
4. That Respondent violated 49 CFR §291.11(b)(4) and 52 Pa. code §37.204 in that it failed observe driver regulations during service. The penalty for this violation is \$100.

WHEREFORE, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement Prosecutory Staff hereby requests that the Commission fine Parrish Transportation, Inc., the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for the illegal activity described in this Complaint.
