- 1. Agency. You hereby appoint StateWise as agent for the purposes of (i) acquiring the supplies necessary to meet Your natural gas supply and/or electric generation service needs, and (ii) arranging, contracting for and administering transportation and related services over transmission facilities and those of the NGDC/EDC needed to deliver natural gas supply and/or electric generation service to Your service address. The Agreement(s) is/are for the sale and purchase of natural gas supply and/or electric generation service and is between StateWise and the customer ("You") under which You shall initiate natural gas supply and/or electricity generation service and begin enrollment with StateWise (the "Agreement(s)"). Subject to the Terms and Conditions of the Agreement(s), StateWise agrees to sell and deliver, and You agree to purchase and accept the quantity of natural gas supply and/or electric generation service, as estimated by StateWise, necessary to meet the requirements based upon consumption data obtained by StateWise or the delivery schedule of Your NGDC/EDC. The amount of natural gas supply and/or electric generation service delivered under the Agreement(s) is/are subject to change based upon data reflecting Your consumption obtained by StateWise or the NGDC/EDC delivery schedule. You acknowledge that You are the Account Holder, or spouse of the Account Holder, over the age of 18 and authorized to make account decisions.
- 2. Length of Agreement(s). StateWise shall use reasonable efforts to commence service to You beginning on Your Start Date. You acknowledge, however, that the actual commencement of service under the Agreement(s) depends upon the date on which Your NGDC/EDC completes all applicable switching and enrollment processes ("Start Date"). You further acknowledge that: the timing for the NGDC/EDC completion of the switching and enrollment processes is beyond StateWise's control, and StateWise makes no warranties as to Your Start Date or Supply Date. The meter reading date on which Your service commences ("Supply Date") may occur as early as three (3) business days after the Start Date. The End Date of Agreement(s) is/are the meter reading date after the entire term of the Agreement(s) (as selected by You on the Account Holder Agreement) from the Supply Date ("Term"), plus any time required to obtain a final meter read.
- 3. Agreement(s) Expiration/Renewal Provisions/Change in Terms: If You have a fixed term Agreement with StateWise that is longer than three (3) months and it is approaching the expiration date, StateWise will send You advance written notices at about ninety (90) days and sixty (60) days before the expiration date. If StateWise proposes to change our terms of service in any type of Agreement, StateWise will send You advance written notices at about ninety (90) days and sixty (60) days before the effective date of the change. If StateWise is billing You directly for our services, then StateWise will provide the notices as a bill message, a bill insert, or in a separate corresponding mailing. If the NGDC is billing StateWise's charges for us, then StateWise will provide the notices in separate corresponding mailings. StateWise will explain Your options to You in these two advance notifications. If You selected natural gas supply, the first notice will be sent between sixty (60) and seventy-five (75) days in advance and the second notice will be sent forty-five (45) days in advance. If You selected electric generation service, the first notice will be sent between forty-five (45) and sixty (60) days in advance and the second notice will be sent at least thirty (30) days in advance. The notice(s) will be sent before the expiration of Your Agreement(s) or effective date of any proposed change(s) to Your current Agreement(s). StateWise will inform You of your right to renew, terminate, or renegotiate the Agreement(s) or effective date of any proposed change(s) to Your current Agreement(s). StateWise will inform You of your right to renew, terminate, or renegotiate the Agreement(s). The then-current Agreement(s) between You and StateWise will be provided to You whenever a material change is made, free of charge to You. As to your rights, if You find the material change on for the proposed to You whenever a material change or penalty to You. Examples of material changes include a change to the pricing structure or extens
- 4. Pricing and Billing. The Basic Service Price selected by You represents the Price that You will pay for the natural gas supply and/or electric generation services provided by StateWise. The Term chosen is inclusive of a two (2) month Introductory Price as indicated on the first page of the Agreement(s). The Basic Service Price, along with your NGDC/EDC charges, will appear in a single bill prepared by your NGDC/EDC. If Your NGDC/EDC is West Penn Power, Duquesne, Met Ed, PECO, Penelec, Penn Power, PPL or UGI, You will be subject to a monthly customer charge (and applicable gross receipts tax), which includes commodity related charges to provide You with the services as outlined on the first page of Your Agreement(s). The monthly customer charge may be prorated based on Your NGDC/EDC billing cycle.
- 5. Cash-Back. If the total supply cost You pay on the Initial Term, over the entire Initial Term of the Agreement(s), is/are greater than the comparable NGDC/EDC supply charge over the same Term, as determined at the end of the Agreement(s), then You may be entitled to Cash-Back. The Cash-Back calculation will be the difference between Your supply payments over the Term of the Agreement(s), and the comparable NGDC/EDC supply charge, of up to a maximum of \$50 if the Initial Term of the Agreement(s) is/are two (2) years or up to \$75 if the Initial Term is three (3) years. These calculations exclude any customer charge that may apply. In order to be eligible for Cash-Back, You must complete the entire Initial Term of the Agreement(s) without interruption and contact StateWise in writing within

ninety (90) days after the completion of the Initial Term of the Agreement(s) at the contact information provided below in Section 16. All Cash-Back payments may be made at the End Date of the Agreement(s) after You have completed Your Term. Cash-Back applies only to the Initial Term of the Agreement(s), not the renewal Term. The calculation(s) excludes any customer charge that may apply and the costs associated with StateWise's Green Electricity (1.98 cents/kWh) and Eco Gas (15 cents/therm or \$1.50/Mcf) Programs (see Section 6).

- 6. StateWise Energy's Earth Save Program. Green Electricity: StateWise will purchase and retire, on Your behalf, an amount of verified carbon emissions reductions, instruments or allowances ("Emissions Credits") to offset 100% (as selected on the first page of the Agreement(s)) of CO<sub>2</sub> or CO<sub>2</sub>e produced based on Your Electricity usage amount. The Emissions Credits associated with the energy offsets purchased to offset Your electricity will remain the legal property of StateWise. StateWise will ensure that all Emissions Credits associated with Your electricity usage will be retired on Your behalf and will not be used to offset any additional emissions or pollution. StateWise, or one of its affiliates, will plant a tree on Your behalf when You select to purchase Emissions Credits under the Green Electricity Program. Eco Gas: StateWise will purchase and retire, on Your behalf, an amount of verified carbon emissions reductions, instruments or allowances ("Emissions Credits") to offset 1.5 tonnes per 1000 therms/Ccf or 100 Mcf (as selected on the first page of the Agreement(s)) of CO<sub>2</sub> or CO<sub>2</sub>e produced based on Your gas usage amount. The Emissions Credits associated with the energy offsets purchased to offset Your gas will remain the legal property of StateWise will ensure that all Emissions Credits associated with Your gas usage will be retired on Your behalf and will not be used to offset any additional emissions or pollution. StateWise, or one of its affiliates, will plant a tree on Your behalf when You select to purchase Emissions Credits under the Eco Gas Program. StateWise reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to change this program and the environmental initiatives it supports. You acknowledge that the price for energy offsets includes Gross Receipt Tax ("GRT") but does not include federal, state and municipal taxes.
- 7. Title. All natural gas supply and/or electricity sold under the Agreement(s) shall be delivered to a location considered the "Point of Delivery", which shall be at the NGDC City Gate (located outside of the municipality where You reside) or EDC load bus, and shall constitute the point at which title transfers and the sale occurs. StateWise will indemnify and hold You harmless from all taxes, royalties, fees or other charges incurred before title passes with respect to the natural gas supply and/or electricity provided in these Agreement(s).
- 8. Cancellation Provision. Regardless of the Basic Service Price selected, You are liable for all StateWise charges until You return to the NGDC/EDC's default service or switch to another supplier. A final bill will be rendered after the final scheduled meter reading; however, if a final meter reading is unavailable, an estimate of consumption will be used in the final bill, which will be trued-up subsequent to the final meter reading. You may rescind the Agreement(s), at no cost, at any time before midnight of the third business day after receiving a copy of this Agreement Document by contacting StateWise. StateWise is not permitted to waive Your three day right of rescission. If the Applicant receives natural gas and/or electric generation service under a small commercial, small industrial or small business rate classification, (and their maximum registered natural gas was less than 300 Mcfs and electricity peak load was less than 25 kW within the last 12 months), the Applicant may rescind the Agreement, at no cost, at any time before midnight of the third business day after receiving a copy of this Agreement Document by contacting StateWise. The cancellation will become effective on a date determined by the NGDC/EDC. The Applicant also agrees to notify StateWise in writing of any other change of information (including a change of account number, contact information or mailing address) at least sixty (60) days prior to such change taking effect or immediately if the change is to take effect in less than sixty (60) days. The Applicant agrees that StateWise may terminate the Agreement(s) at any time by providing forty-five (45) days' written notice if StateWise is unable or is prevented from complying with any of the obligations it owes to the NGDC/EDC or if the NGDC/EDC is unable or is prevented from complying with any of the obligations it owes to StateWise. StateWise may terminate the Agreement(s) if the Applicant is in default. To cancel/rescind the contract, You should contact StateWise by telephone or in writing at the contact information provided below in Section 16. If You move from Your current Service Address, the Agreement(s) will be deemed to be cancelled. See PA Code 54.5 (c)(7). StateWise may cancel the Agreement(s) by providing ninety (90) days and forty-five (45) days' written notice to You. The cancellation will become effective on a date determined by the NGDC/EDC. Reasons for cancellation may include but are not limited to:

Non-Payment – If Your natural gas supply and/or electric generation service is cancelled by Your NGDC/EDC, then the Agreement(s) are cancelled on the date that Your natural gas supply and/or electric generation service is cancelled.

Net Meter Customers - StateWise may cancel the electricity Agreement if StateWise is notified that You have a net meter.

Customer Move – When a customer moves from one location to another, even if the move is within an NGDC/EDC's service territory, the Agreement is cancelled, regardless of whether the customer provides notice or not.

Usage – StateWise reserves the right to decline the Agreement(s) if Your natural gas supply and/or electric generation service is determined by StateWise to be too low. This determination shall be at the sole discretion of StateWise.

Material Breach - You have breached the Agreement(s) in any way.

Regulatory Changes – If, at some future date, there is a change in any law, rule, regulation or pricing structure whereby StateWise is prevented, prohibited, or frustrated from carrying out the terms of the Agreement(s).

- 9. Early Termination Fee. An early termination fee of \$2.50, plus applicable taxes, for each month or partial month remaining on the natural gas supply and/or electric generation service. This early termination fee shall apply if You cancel the Agreement(s) at any time after three (3) business days of either signing or receiving a copy the Agreement(s). If the Applicant receives natural gas and/or electric generation service under a small commercial, small industrial or small business rate classification and if the Agreement is terminated because the Applicant is in default, unless for a reason that is beyond the control of the Applicant, early termination fees of \$0.18/Ccf, \$1.80/Mcf or \$0.18/therm and \$0.015 per kWh may apply for the estimated usage of the natural gas and/or electric generation service, plus applicable taxes, for the remaining Term of each Agreement (s) Term will apply if the Agreement(s) is/are terminated prior to the end of the Term selected on the front page of the Agreement(s).
- 10. Assignment. You may not assign Your interests in or delegate Your obligations under this Agreement. StateWise may sell, transfer, pledge, or assign the accounts receivable, revenues, or proceeds hereof, in connection with any financing agreement, purchase of accounts receivables program or billing services agreement, and may assign the Agreement and the rights and obligations thereunder, to another energy supplier, energy services company or other entity as authorized by the PUC, by providing You with thirty (30) days' notice.
- 11. Information Release Authorization. You authorize StateWise to obtain and review information regarding Your credit history from credit reporting agencies and the following information from the NGDC/EDC: consumption history; billing determinants; utility account number; credit information; and public assistance status. This information will not be disclosed to a third party unless required by law. Your execution of the Agreement(s) shall constitute authorization for the release of this information to StateWise. You may consent to providing StateWise with a copy of Your utility bill(s) in order to process the Agreement(s) with the NGDC/EDC. StateWise does not guarantee to provide or return the bill or a copy of the bill to You upon Your request. This authorization will remain in effect during the initial Term and any renewal Term of the Agreement(s). You may rescind this authorization at any time by providing written notice thereof to StateWise or by calling StateWise at 1-877-316-6344. StateWise reserves the right to cancel the Agreement(s) in the event You rescind the authorization.
- 12. Warranty. The Agreement(s) for natural gas supply and/or electric generation services, including applicable attachments, constitutes the entire Agreement(s) for the supply of natural gas supply and/or electric generation services between You and StateWise. StateWise makes no representations or warranties other than those expressly set forth in the Agreement(s) and StateWise expressly disclaims all other warranties, expressed or implied, including merchantability and fitness for a particular use.
- 13. Email Bonus Program. If You provide a valid email address, StateWise will enter You into a minimum of one (1) draw per year for prizes to be awarded at the sole discretion of StateWise. - 14. Force Majeure. StateWise will make commercially reasonable efforts to provide natural gas supply and/or electric generation services hereunder but StateWise does not guarantee a continuous supply of natural gas supply and/or electric generation services to You. Certain causes and events out of the control of StateWise ("Force Majeure Events") may result in interruptions in service. StateWise will not be liable for any such interruptions caused by a Force Majeure Event, and StateWise is not and shall not be liable for damages caused by Force Majeure Events. Force Majeure Events shall include but are not limited to acts of God, fire, flood, storm, terrorism, war, civil disturbance, acts of any governmental authority, accidents, strikes, labor disputes or problems, required maintenance work, inabil-

ity to access the necessary distribution or transmission system, non-performance by the NGDC/EDC (including, but not limited to, a facility outage on its natural gas supply and/or electricity distribution lines), changes in laws, rules, or regulations of any governmental authority or any other cause beyond StateWise's control.

- 15. Liability. The remedy in any claim or suit by You will be solely limited to direct actual damages. By entering into the Agreement, You waive any right to any other remedy in law or equity. In no event will either StateWise or You be liable for consequential, incidental, indirect, special or punitive damages. These limitations apply without regard to the cause of any liability or damages. There are no third-party beneficiaries to the Agreement.
