**MOTION OF BELFIELD COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO
WITHDRAW FORMAL COMPLAINT**

Belfield Community Development Corporation ("Belfield"), hereby motions to withdraw the company's formal complaint, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.94(a) and states the following:

1. Belfield filed a formal complaint on or about October 10, 2017 in the above captioned matter.
2. The parties in the above captioned matter appeared at an initial hearing before Administrative Law Judge Angela T. Jones on July 9, 2018.
3. During the course of the aforesaid hearing before Judge Jones, the parties in the above captioned matter arrived at a stipulated judgment and payment agreement that satisfied the aims of all parties and thereby nullified the need for further administrative hearings before the Commission.
4. The relevant terms of the agreement are: Belfield will pay its outstanding balance of \$15,143.42. Belfield shall pay \$1,000 toward this balance within ten (10) days of the hearing before Judge Jones on July 9, 2018. Belfield shall pay the remainder of the outstanding balance over the period of twenty-four (24) month repayment term on the balance, plus current bills.
5. As a result of the stipulated judgment and the corresponding payment arrangement, Belfield respectfully requests to withdraw the company's formal complaint against PECO Energy.
6. 52 Pa. Code § 5.94(a) states:


Except as provided in subsection (b), a party desiring to withdraw a pleading in a contested proceeding may file a petition for leave to withdraw the appropriate document with the Commission and serve it upon the other parties. The petition must set forth the

reasons for the withdrawal. A party may object to the petition within 20 days of service. After considering the petition, an objection thereto and the public interest, the presiding officer or the Commission will determine whether the withdrawal will be permitted.

7. "Pleading" is defined as "an application, complaint, petition, answer, motion, protest, reply, or other similar document filed in a proceeding." 52 Pa. Code § 1.8(a.).
8. Belfield respectfully requests to withdraw the formal complaint.
9. A further hearing in this matter is not required because the issue is no longer contested.
10. Not holding a hearing for this matter is in the public interest because it saves the Commission time and resources.
11. Accordingly, Belfield Community Development respectfully requests that this Honorable Commission grant PECO Energy's Motion to Withdraw the formal complaint at docket number C-2017-2625808, and cancel any remaining hearings associated with this matter.

WHEREFORE, Belfield respectfully requests that this Honorable Commission grant Belfield Community Development Corporation Motion to Withdraw Formal Complaint.
