7. FINANCIAL FITNESS

CRITICAL BONDING NOTES:

Applicant is required to maintain a bond or other financial instrument the entire time it maintains an EGS license with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. If Applicant's security instrument is not continuous, Applicant **MUST** submit a Rider, Amendment, or Continuation Certificate annually based on the expiration date of its security instrument.

At least sixty days (60) prior to the security instrument's expiration date, Applicant should contact Stephen Jakab at sjakab@pa.gov to determine the appropriate bonding amount based on a percentage of Applicant's gross receipts resulting from the sale of generated electricity consumed in Pennsylvania. Once the amount has been determined, Applicant should overnight the updated security instrument(s) at least thirty (30) days prior to the expiration date to ensure adequate time for staff review and approval of the security instrument(s).

- **The Treasurer or other appropriate officer of Applicant shall transmit to the Department of Revenue by March 15, an annual report, and under oath or affirmation, of the amount of gross receipts received by Applicant during the prior calendar year.**
- **Net Metering Reports:** Applicant shall be responsible to report any Net Metering per the Standards on http://www.puc.pa.gov/consumer_info/electricity/alternative_energy.aspx. Scroll down to the Net Metering Standards Section.
- **Applicant shall report to the Commission the percentages of total electricity supplied by each fuel source on an annual basis per 52 Pa. Code § 54.39(d).**
- **Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.**

Distribution or Delivery Prices for Electricity	The charges for moving electric generation services from the EDC to Your Service Address.

Subject to the Terms and Conditions of the Agreement(s), StateWise agrees to sell and deliver, and You agree to purchase and accept the quantity of natural gas supply and/or electric generation service, as estimated by StateWise, necessary to meet the requirements based upon consumption data obtained by StateWise or the delivery schedule of Your NGDC/EDC. The amount of natural gas supply and/or electric generation service delivered under the Agreement(s) is/are subject to change based upon data reflecting Your consumption obtained by StateWise or the NGDC/EDC delivery schedule. You acknowledge that You are the Account Holder, or spouse of the Account Holder, over the age of 18 and authorized to make account decisions.

2. Length of Agreement(s). StateWise shall use reasonable efforts to commence service to You beginning on Your Start Date. You acknowledge, however, that the actual commencement of service under the Agreement(s) depends upon the date on which Your NGDC/EDC completes all applicable switching and enrollment processes ("Start Date"). You further acknowledge that: the timing for the NGDC/EDC completion of the switching and enrollment processes is beyond StateWise's control, and StateWise makes no warranties as to Your Start Date or Supply Date. The meter reading date on which Your service commences ("Supply Date") may occur as early as three (3) business days after the Start Date. The End Date of Agreement(s) is/are the meter reading date after the entire term of the Agreement(s) (as selected by You on the Account Holder Agreement) from the Supply Date ("Term"), plus any time required to obtain a final meter read.

3. Agreement(s) Expiration/Renewal Provisions/Change in Terms: If You have a fixed term Agreement with StateWise that is longer than three (3) months and it is approaching the expiration date, StateWise will send You advance written notices at about ninety (90) days and sixty (60) days before the expiration date. If StateWise proposes to change our terms of service in any type of Agreement, StateWise will send You advance written notices at about ninety (90) days and sixty (60) days before the effective date of the change. If StateWise is billing You directly for our services, then StateWise will provide the notices as a bill message, a bill insert, or in a separate corresponding mailing. If the NGDC is billing StateWise's charges for us, then StateWise will provide the notices in separate corresponding mailings. StateWise will explain Your options to You in these two advance notifications. If You selected natural gas supply, the first notice will be sent between sixty (60) and seventy-five (75) days in advance and the second notice will be sent forty-five (45) days in advance. If You selected electric generation service, the first notice will be sent between forty-five (45) and sixty (60) days in advance and the second notice will be sent at least thirty (30) days in advance. The notice(s) will be sent before the expiration of Your Agreement(s) or effective date of any proposed change(s) to Your current Agreement(s). StateWise will inform You of your right to renew, terminate, or renegotiate the Agreement(s). The Basic Service Price, along with your NGDC/EDC charges, will appear in a single bill prepared by your NGDC/EDC. If Your NGDC/EDC is West Penn Power, Duquesne, Met Ed, PECO, Penelec, Penn Power, PPL or UGI, You will be subject to a monthly customer charge (and applicable gross receipts tax), which includes commodity related charges to provide You with the services as outlined on the first page of Your Agreement(s). 5. Cash-Back. If the total supply cost You pay on the Initial Term, over the entire Initial Term of the Agreement(s), is/are greater than the comparable NGDC/EDC supply charge over the same Term, as determined at the end of the Agreement(s), then You may be entitled to Cash-Back. The Cash-Back calculation will be the difference between Your supply payments over the Term of the Agreement(s), and the comparable NGDC/EDC supply charge, of up to a maximum of \$50 if the Initial Term of the Agreement(s) is/are two (2) years or up to \$75 if the Initial Term is three (3) years. These calculations exclude any customer charge that may apply. 8. Cancellation Provision. Regardless of the Basic Service Price selected, You are liable for all StateWise charges until You return to the NGDC/EDC's default service or switch to another supplier. A final bill will be rendered after the final scheduled meter reading; however, if a final meter reading is unavailable, an estimate of consumption will be used in the final bill, which will be true-up subsequent to the final meter reading. The cancellation will become effective on a date determined by the NGDC/EDC. The Applicant also agrees to notify StateWise in writing of any other change of information (including a change of account number, contact information or mailing address) at least sixty (60) days prior to such change taking effect or immediately if the change is to take effect in less than sixty (60) days. The Applicant agrees that StateWise may terminate the Agreement(s) at any time by providing forty-five (45) days' written notice if StateWise is unable or is prevented from complying with any of the obligations it owes to the NGDC/EDC or if the NGDC/EDC is unable or is prevented from complying with any of the obligations it owes to StateWise. StateWise may terminate the Agreement(s) if the Applicant is in default. To cancel/rescind the contract, You should contact StateWise by telephone or in writing at the contact information provided below in Section 16. If You move from Your current Service Address, the Agreement(s) will be deemed to be cancelled. See PA Code 54.5 (c)(7). StateWise may cancel the Agreement(s) by providing ninety (90) days and forty-five (45) days' written notice to You. The cancellation will become effective on a date determined by the NGDC/EDC. Net Meter Customers – StateWise may cancel the electricity Agreement if StateWise is notified that You have a net meter.

Customer Move – When a customer moves from one location to another, even if the move is within an NGDC/EDC's service territory, the Agreement is cancelled, regardless of whether the customer provides notice or not.

This information will not be disclosed to a third party unless required by law. Your execution of the Agreement(s) shall constitute authorization for the release of this information to StateWise. You may consent to providing StateWise with a copy of Your utility bill(s) in order to process the Agreement(s) with the NGDC/EDC. StateWise does not guarantee to provide or return the bill or a copy of the bill to You upon Your request. This authorization will remain in effect during the initial Term and any renewal Term of the Agreement(s). You may rescind this authorization at any time by providing written notice thereof to StateWise or by calling StateWise at 1-877-316-6344. StateWise reserves the right to cancel the Agreement(s) in the event You rescind the authorization.

12. Warranty. The Agreement(s) for natural gas supply and/or electric generation services, including applicable attachments, constitutes the entire Agreement(s) for the supply of natural gas supply and/or electric generation services between You and StateWise.
