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Dear Judge Angela T. Jones,

I would like to amend my formal complaint that not only PGW has disrupted my living by removing the gas meter without proper reason, but it has also caused the damage on financially and mentally. My lifestyle has been disrupted and harmed due to this unacceptable act. From Previous judgement, I understand PGW has agreed to reinstall the gas meter and restart my gas service under my name on August 13. I agree to provide PGW with access to my property (5428 Howland Street, Philadelphia PA) However, that would not conclude my complaint by just restoring the service. I'm submitting the prove and report for your review, and I would like PGW to address the pain and damage they caused.

- After the unreasonable removal of the gas meter, I had contacted PGW numerous times to address and request the meter issue. I had requested that PGW to restore the service if there was not any proper reason of that meter had not been function properly. However I had not gotten any proper response from PGW. with the winter was approaching fast, I had to consider other options to situatie this issue for the cold season. I had to pay the heating company to replace the natural gas boiler with the LP boiler. (see attached receipt)
- Once the new boiler has been installed, that's when my pain just begun, I had to constantly check on the LP usage, and frequently driving down from NJ to refill the tanks. I have to do that even nowadays. I shouldn't need to do this, but if it wasn't for the problem caused by PGW's wrongfully, and unreasonably force the situation upon me. I had no choice.
- So regarding to restoring of the gas meter and service, I still need to contact the heating company to reinstall the original boiler prior the arrival of PGW technician on 8/13. The original boiler has been stored in the backyard, it's still questionable whether it's able to function properly after the brutal winter. I'm not certain if there is a need to purchase a new boiler, and all these need to be in extra cost, and I'm currently don't have the receipt due to the work has not been started. That's the fact I need to added into my complaints.

With my statements above, I strongly request that under your honor's authority and power, PGW should compensate my financial damage of \$7500, \$5000 has been paid to the heating company for the replacement of the boiler, and \$2500 will be used for the payment of restoration. I thank you for your judgement. Much appreciated.
