Dear Ms. Chiavetta

Previous letters of April and May contained my objections and a second copy of my signed copy.

Between October 2017 and June 8 I had been at my daughter, Colleen Goodwin's place for personal care of health reasons. June 8, 2018 I travelled to my primary doctor in Allison Park of UPMC for a follow-up examination and then returned to my home at 5 P.M. same date.

Since I had poor mail service, my neighbor had agreed to gather my mail daily for about 8-10 days which he did from my mail box. I found the letter dated May 24, 2018 from Attorney Jeremy V. Farrell. It contained "motion to Quash" my objections. (Otherwise, I probably would not ^{have} received any mail.)

As far back as 4-30-18 I tried with higher officials in Pittsburgh for guidance and help. They even gave me a case no, 137-778-164 (about 4-25-18). I tried the West Mifflin Office (412) 658-3836 and each of 2 successive calls I wanted 42 ring 27) no answer. I learned they have no answering services. Now, being back home, I hope to rely on my neighbor for "Mr. Bobetovet."

When I finally had your correspondence catch up with me, I knew the due dates were untenable as I explained in each of my previous 2 letters. You acknowledged the letters with ~~apologies~~ of due dates with great satisfaction -- all because of unavoidable circumstances with mail problems.

I am here, I don't understand the attorney's motion to quash my exceptions, as he mentions in TPs 1 and 2 of his letter dated May 24, 2018. When my extension requests were acknowledged as reported by your office, I can't understand why he is over-ruling your decision by turning back "his untimely clock" with his motion.

Under "factual background" TP 5-27 is his capsulized summary of the contents of this case. It is no different than the 15 or so appendices of an accountant's bills during ~~over~~ meeting... Monthly claims usage by the D & C.

Reference #25 --- complainant's letter dated May 13, 2018 is an attempt to file exceptions to the initial decision, it should be quashed because it is "untimely." This style of logic of his makes no sense whatsoever to me. It seems that he is exporting your extensions to his resorting to the initial decision, which implies he is overruling your authority of decision making.

I can't help it, I was sick! I can't help for the post mail service by the West Virginia Post office. I can't control or help for other implications he makes. His use of my "attempt" in #25 is the persistent use of subjective opinion and judgment as motivation to "justify" "untimely." He presents no absolute premises of or for a "truth." He seems to want to play or re-play the process ^{ing} ~~his~~ ~~merit~~ or playbook.

Reference #26. Does it really make any sense for his reserving the right of D & C as a cover for whatever he is thinking of? I strongly believe this entry is by far another overruling the spirit of the

DLC in reporting monthly ranges, threats to shut down power, more proofs for my out-of-state and home area travels, my health issues, etc.

At the original hearing, I requested by suggestion for DLC to send a personal electrician to learn of the reason my furnace kept operating for 8-9 days when they changed the meter. And, again in the letters of request for extensions I made the same invitation. No one has called regarding my invitation, nor showed up, nor sent an objection, nor a letter of refusal.

How much more can I be truthful, forthright, and presenting them what I have done to work with DLC? Has the attorney informed the officials of these open requests? I don't think so.

By the way, when I received the attorney's letter of May 24, 2018, a Thursday date, he imposed a response to his motion to quench my "exceptions" within 20 days of service hereof - - -

I made a call to his office on Friday or Monday of this week to speak with him. He was on vacation according to his secretary. I called, then to speak with his colleague Attorney Laurin Pulli. I left a message on her phone to call me. A second message I also left. She has not returned any of these 2 calls. My purpose was to ask her to provide me with a calendar date of the 20 day extensions.

My experiences acknowledge a 5 day work week that doesn't include Saturdays and Sundays and of course no mail on Sunday.

(a) His letter of May 24, 2018 plus 20 consecutive days equals June 15. not allowing for delivery times.

(b.) Receipt of letter June 8, 2018 plus 20 consecutive days equals June 29, 2018 not allowing for delivery time.

(c.) His letter of June 8, 2018 plus 5 (M-F) work days equals July 6, 2018 (by weeks)

Being not knowing, in doing the best I can for trying the best option by rushing.

Madam Secretary, again I thank you for your gracious accommodations to my exceptions that are timely rather than untimely. I can't turn back the clock. Please consider my communications as a real effort to reach my complaint through the enclosures of my previous letter.

At my age of 89, living by myself, cook, bottle washer and all the tasks and duties a man has for survival many times don't fit the timely 24^{hour} day but untimely 20 hours to fit in each day.

I have proved everything in my lifetime that I possibly and justifiably can. "Time is out of joint..." said Hamlet. I'm trying to fit it right with duty and justice. I hope the ruling is favorable to cover my time and material expenses as a lay person. See my social security statement. Social security was not started for teachers until school year 1958 but I would have had to pay \$250- dues further, previous 2 years I taught after separation from US Air Force. On an average \$2400- I could not afford it while taking care of my mother. A classic example of "if post~~er~~ facta." Depression lasted for me

Madam Secretary, I have made every effort to justify my claims against D L C, including the postal service, I recommend calling the Consumer of Postal affairs office of Pittsburgh and ask to speak with Lorraine or Kelly and others live spoken with concerning poor mail service. Or call me to relate any details. I have absolute proof of receipt of mail that took 3-5 weeks of delivery. Let it be forgotten, the attorney makes no acknowledgement of proof that I was out of state for the years I cited plus being in harm with my daughter for 6 plus months with her nursing care. And not receiving this "quashing" letter until June 8, 2018.

And no mention of the 2 statements I included to double down my verbal statements "I was out of state" all of which he accused me of not proving it. My word is honest proof.

His procrastinations are causing me anxieties. I'm enclosing a statement from the social security office of my benefits to verify my concern and every of payment have been charged for. I began in 1958 for teachers but the government charged taxes for the 2 years I worked as teacher before 1958. A case of Ex Post Facto. I could not afford paying on \$2400 the FICA tax. I took care of my mother that required strict budgeting and a life of poverty.

Thank you again for the service you provided me these years. May God bless and your loved ones.


