This letter is in response to Tori Giesler's letter dated July 25, 2018, requesting denial of the 120-day extension of time.

As I stated before in my previous request, my family has had two deaths recently, which has taken much of my time and will continue as we deal with the estate. In addition, our home was flooded several times this year with heavy rains and we are in the process of major construction to correct the problem. A West Penn Power technician even took a photo of the house under repair.

First Energy has full time lawyers to handle these cases, and I am not a lawyer. It takes me a very long time to go through the statutes, go into the legislative history of the statutes, go into the history of the PUC rulings, and the precedence. I need a significant portion of that time just to acquire that information. This is not what I do every day, and do not have instant access to this information like the lawyers do who are opposing me. This is an attack on me and my family and my property, and I need to be able to do a competent job.

Please consider my request favorably.
