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7. FINANCIAL FITNESS

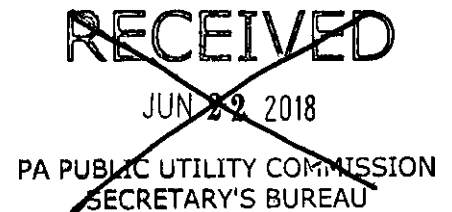

Once the amount has been determined, Applicant should overnight the updated security instrument(s) at least thirty (30) days prior to the expiration date to ensure adequate time for staff review and approval of the security instrument(s).

Erie Energy Partners LLC will make each customer sign a Letter of Authorization that we will submit to suppliers when issuing a bid. This not only shows consent that we are shopping electricity rates on the customer's behalf, but also provides the supplier with proper authorization to request historical usage data from the utility for quoting purposes.

Erie Energy Partners LLC will initially review all rates and terms with our customers and again once a term is selected by the customer. Erie Energy Partners LLC will do this with each customer to certify the supplier is following the standards and pricing practices for retail electricity services spelled out in PA Code § 54.3 for large commercial/ industrial customers. For small business, we will certify that the marketing guidelines spelled out in PA Code § 54.7 are met.

Erie Energy Partners LLC will handle/review all contractual paperwork to ensure an accurate enrollment with the utility. After the customer signs with a supplier for the contracted rate, Erie Energy Partners LLC will notify the customer 2-3 months in advance of contract expiration by phone or email to address renewal rate options.

Erie Energy Partners LLC will have a vetting process when it comes to partnering with suppliers. Our goal is to only work with suppliers that are credible, trustworthy, and competitive.

- Applicant shall report to the Commission the percentages of total electricity supplied by each fuel source on an annual basis per 52 Pa. Code § 54.39(d).
- Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.





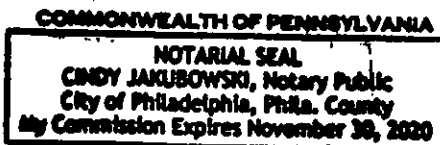
