PECO Energy Company ("PECO"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby request a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter as follows:

1. An in person hearing for this matter is currently scheduled to take place on Friday, August 31, 2018 at 10:00 a.m.
2. The Complainant alleges in his formal complaint that he believes his meter had foreign wiring attached causing additional charges to his electric bill.
3. At the hearing, PECO will present the testimony of High Bill Foreman, Thomas Lerro, who will testify regarding a high bill investigation conducted at the premises.
4. Mr. Lerro is scheduled for vacation the day of the hearing.
5. The testimony of Mr. Lerro is critical to PECO's defense, particularly as he is the company's specialist for high bill and foreign wiring allegations and has technical knowledge of the Complainant's claims.


