MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING DATE

PECO Energy Company ("PECO"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby request a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter as follows:

1. An in person hearing for this matter is currently scheduled to take place on Thursday, August 23, 2018 at 10:00 a.m.
2. The Complainants allege in their formal complaint that their bills are very high for 2016 and 2017, and now after investigation their 2018 bills are lower.
3. PECO Energy's counsel, Shawane L. Lee, is scheduled for vacation the day of the hearing. Accordingly, Ms. Lee is unable to cover the hearing.
4. Pursuant to 52 Pa.Code § 1.15(b), a request for a change of the scheduled hearing date must be submitted by motion in writing, filed no later than five (5) days prior to the hearing with the Commission. The motion must state the facts upon which the request rests.
5. Consistent with 52 Pa.Code § 1.15(b), PECO respectfully requests a change of the scheduled hearing date due to counsel's unavailability.
6. PECO has reached out to the Complainants and they have no objection to PECO's request.


7. The Prehearing Order in this matter states that requests for a continuance are only granted “in rare situations where good cause exists.” (Prehearing Order, citing 52 Pa. Code § 1.15).

8. PECO Energy avers that “good cause” exists to continue the scheduled hearing to another date because PECO Energy’s counsel, who is knowledgeable of the facts, circumstances and evidence, concerning the Complainant’s formal complaint against the company is not available to represent the company.

9. PECO will be prejudiced if this matter proceeds without the company’s in house counsel who has the experience and knowledge of the company’s processes, facts and evidence.

10. PECO Energy therefore respectfully requests that the hearing be continued to a further date.
