Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Enclosed for filing with the Commission are the above-referenced application and related filings of SUEZ Water Pennsylvania Inc. ("SWPA") for its acquisition of the wastewater collection and conveyance system of the Township of Mahoning. This filing is made pursuant to Sections 507 (related to filing of contracts with municipal corporations), 1102 (related to certificates of public convenience), and 1329 (determination of fair market value for ratemaking purposes) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code ("Code"), Pa. C.S. §§ 507, 1102, and 1329.

Copies of the Application have been served upon the public advocates in accordance with the attached Certificate of Service and in accordance with the Commission's *Final Implementation Order* entered October 27, 2016, at Docket No. M-2016-2543193. Due to the size of the filing, I have also enclosed the following four CD-Roms for your convenience: (1) the PUC Application filing (without Confidential Documents); (2) Live Excel Spreadsheets of the Seller Utility Valuation Expert's workpapers in appraising the System; (3) Live Excel Spreadsheets of the Buyer Utility Valuation Expert's workpapers in appraising the system; and, (4) **Confidential Documents**. I have also enclosed the required \$350 application filing fee (Check No. 246697).

***SWPA has placed Confidential appendices to the Application in a separate sealed envelope. These Confidential appendices include Appendix A-24-a. Such attachments should be placed in a non-public folder by the Secretary's Bureau in accordance with the Commission's standard practice for proprietary information.***


