

**Application of SUEZ Water Pennsylvania Inc. for the Acquisition of Wastewater Assets of
the Township of Mahoning Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §1329

13. Provide a proposed tariff containing a rate equal to the existing rates of the seller at the time of the acquisition and a rate stabilization plan, if applicable to the acquisition.

RESPONSE: See enclosed *pro forma* Tariff Supplement No. XX to Tariff Wastewater – Pa. P.U.C. No. 2, containing initial rates equal to the existing rates of the Township of Mahoning at the time of the acquisition. After Closing, residential customers will be billed monthly rather than quarterly, but the monthly rate charged by SUEZ Water Pennsylvania Inc. (“SWPA”) will be 1/3 of the amount that residential customers are currently charged by Mahoning.

The rate commitments set forth in the Asset Purchase Agreement do not technically fall within the definition of a “rate stabilization plan” as defined by 66 Pa. C.S. § 1329 because SWPA has not made any commitments to control rates beyond SWPA’s first post-closing base rate case. Nevertheless, SWPA has submitted direct testimony in support of the rate commitments contained in the APA. See Direct Testimony of John Hollenbach, Vice President and General Manager of SWPA, SWPA Statement No. 1, p. 12, enclosed at **Appendix A-14**.

Surcharges

All bills shall be increased by 25% based upon a charge by Danville to Mahoning. In addition, an additional 15% shall be applied to the resultant bill based upon a Danville increase effective January 1, 2017.

Conditions of Contract:

The volume charge is based on all metered domestic water consumed by a customer during the billing period, except as otherwise provided. A wastewater customer who has water supplied by sources other than SUEZ Water Pennsylvania, shall be required to maintain a meter for the purpose of measuring water flow to any structure determined to be served by the wastewater collection system.

Terms of Payment:

Bills for service under this Schedule will be rendered monthly or quarterly in the arrears at the rates shown above, and are payable within twenty (20) days after the date the bill is rendered.
