RESPONSE:

- c. SWPA is purchasing a wastewater collection and conveyance system; it does not have productive or treatment capacity. However, see the Agreement dated January 22, 1968 among Danville Municipal Authority, Borough of Danville and Mahoning Township Authority, attached as **Appendix B-6**, as amended by an Amendment dated May 21, 1985. According to that amended agreement, Mahoning's Wastewater System may transport an average flow of 1,113,000 gallons per day to Danville's wastewater system for treatment and disposition. For a discussion of the pipe sizes and material used for construction of the wastewater collection and conveyance facilities, see the Engineer's Assessment, attached as **Appendix A-15-a**, and Exhibit 1.1 to the Asset Purchase Agreement, attached as **Appendix A-24-a (CONFIDENTIAL)**.
