This is my written response to a notice to plead dated July 23, 2018 and signed by Lauren M Lepkoski, Esquire. See attached.


I have read the information attached to the Notice to Plead and, for the most part, do not understand it's relevance to my objection to the installation of a smart meter at 420 Snyder RD, Reading PA 19605. As stated in reason 1 in response to question 5 of my formal complaint.

Contained in the documents attached to the above noted notice to plead, there are many statements submitted by Met-Ed, which indeed may be factual, but which do not address my concern about the effects of smart meter transmissions on the environment, in this case my body.

Both Met-Ed and the PUC are mute, as far as I can determine, on health considerations in their discussions, regulations, or other decrees regarding smart meter transmissions. It is my belief that I have the right to live in a safe environment and it has not been shown that Smart Meter transmissions provide that safe environment.

This is a simple matter, do not install a smart meter on the location stated above until I am provided with information showing that Smart Meter transmissions are not harmful to a human body.



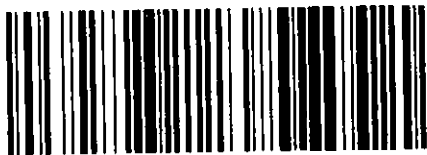
