To whom it may concern,

It has been requested by the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission that official correspondence be sent to clarify the fact that Anadarko Petroleum Corporation no longer operates pipelines in the state of Pennsylvania. Anadarko Petroleum Corporation previously owned and operated both Class 1 and Class 2 gas gathering pipelines, of which the latter there were approximately 10.39 miles. These operated assets were divested to Alta Marcellus Development, LLC, a wholly owned subsidiary of Alta Resources Development, LLC.

Furthermore, it is our understanding that in April of 2017, Anadarko Petroleum Corporation e-filed, through the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commissions website, the appropriate document to deregister our registration under ACT 127.
