Sterner's Moving and Transporting Inc. ("Respondent") has paid, in full, its outstanding assessment balance for the July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017 Fiscal Year ("2016-2017 Fiscal Year") and the civil penalty to resolve the above-docketed complaint without litigation.

On August 28, 2018, the Commission received a check from Respondent in the amount of \$434, which constitutes payment of Respondent's outstanding assessment balance of \$377 for the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year, as well as \$57 related to the civil penalty for Respondent's failure to timely pay the Commission's assessment.
