PECO is aware that Erie Energy Partners LLC has applied for a license to provide brokering and consulting services to commercial and industrial customers on the distribution system of PECO.

In making such an application, Erie Energy Partners LLC could be required to provide to PECO a bond or other acceptable financial security in an amount that PECO determines to be appropriate. 
