AND NOW, Janet E. Cole, answers the above captioned Response to Answer and
New Matter of Metropolitan Edison Company to the Complaint of Janet E. Cole.

4. Deny. Metropolitan Edison Company is threatening to shut off my electric service to my property unless I allow them to install a "Smart Meter" hereinafter "Controller". Original reasons for denial of installation are listed on Formal Complaint. The Federal Energy Act of 2005 states that said Controllers are to be installed at customer's request, not forced upon customers at the risk of their health, safety, security and privacy. Act 129 also states that Controllers are to be requested by the customer. The issues that you are referring to as the Complainant's belief rather than allegations of fact is not true. Every so called belief can be verified by hundreds of doctors, scientists and testing of the Controllers. The rules, acts and regulations that are referred to do not supersede the Federal Energy Act of 2005 BECAUSE THE DEPLOYMENT OF THE ITRON CONTROLLERS ARE FUNDED BY FEDERAL GRANTS. Nor do they supersede Old English Law and the duty of my Creator to keep my home safe and secure. It is against God's laws. There is no precedent to your rules, acts and regulations as stated. Every case is different and certainly my case is unique.
5. Deny. Everything stated in the attached letter as my response to Requested Relief. Metropolitan Edison Company states that they deny the allegations for which no response is required, silence i.e. No response is admission of consent.

6. Agree. No Protection from Abuse has been requested or granted as of this date.
7. Agree. This is not an appeal from a decision of the PUC.
8. Agree. I am not represented at this time by a lawyer

10. Agree. I mailed the completed form with my signature by certified mail No. 7015 1660 0000 7633 7578.
- 11, 12, 13 and 14. Denied. A letter was sent to Met-Ed on April 15, 2013. I was in touch with my State Representative, Mark Rozzi. He wasn't very familiar with these Controllars and I dropped off a lot of information at his office for him. I didn't document the date but it was approximately one and one-half years ago. The Formal Complaint should not be dismissed for failure to contact the Company prior to the filing of the Formal Complaint. See attached letter.

21. Deny. These Controllars are in violation of the 4th Amendment of the Constitution of the United States. Controllars are by definition, surveillance devices which violate Federal and State wiretapping by recording and storing data bases of private and personal activities without the consent or knowledge of those who are being monitored. Metropolitan Edison Company has not adequately disclosed the particular recording and transmission capabilities of the Controller or the extent of the data that will be recorded, stored and shared, or the purposes to which the data will and not be put. Metropolitan Edison Company must take liability for the Controllars, knowing full well the dangers to humans, property,


animals and plants. This proposal is both evil and against the laws of nature and God. See #4.

22. Deny. If you can jeopardize people's health and privacy you certainly can violate what you call Act 129. As stated earlier, Act 129 was supposed to be requested, not shoved down our throats. It is also criminal to violate the Federal Energy Act of 2005 when you accepted the federal grants to deploy these so called meters.

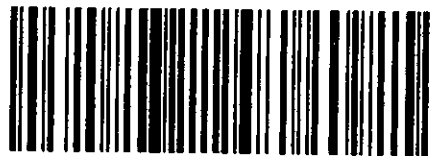

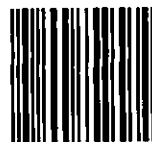
