MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING


Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), Philadelphia Gas Works ("PGW"), hereby submits this request for a continuance of the hearing in this matter, which is scheduled for Friday, September 7, 2018. In support of its motion, PGW states as follows:

1. By Notice dated July 26, 2018, the Commission scheduled an In-Person Hearing in this matter for Friday, September 7, 2018 at 10:00 a.m., before Administrative Law Judge Christopher P. Pell.
2. Pursuant to paragraph 5 of the Prehearing Order issued in this matter on June 14, 2018, PGW contacted the Complainant to discuss settlement.
3. During the course of the settlement discussion, the Complainant raised the issue of a possible foreign load in the building where she resides at 6529 Walnut Park Drive. The Complainant expressed the belief that she was paying for gas consumed in other units.
4. PGW has initiated a foreign load investigation and is in the process of contacting the landlord to schedule a field visit.
5. PGW requests a continuance so it may complete the foreign load investigation.
6. The foreign load investigation was initiated at the Complainant's request and she has no objection to a Continuance for this purpose.

WHEREFORE, PGW requests that the hearing scheduled for Friday, September 7, 2018, in the above captioned matter be continued and rescheduled.
