The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("Commission") Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement ("I&E") files this Petition for Leave to Withdraw the Complaint in the above-captioned case pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.94.


On January 8, 2018, I&E filed a Complaint alleging that Accent Fuels, Inc. ("Respondent") violated Section 510(c) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 510(c), for failing to satisfy its July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017 Fiscal Year ("2016-2017 Fiscal Year") Assessment of \$16,220. In addition to payment of the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year Assessment, I&E sought payment of a civil penalty in the amount of \$2,433.

Upon further investigation, I&E determined that Respondent filed a timely objection to its 2016-2017 Fiscal Year Assessment wherein it explained that it made an error when reporting its gross intrastate operating revenues on its assessment report for the 2015 calendar year and provided a revised 2015 Assessment Report. On January 22, 2018, the Commission issued a revised assessment to Respondent for the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year. On February 1, 2018, Respondent paid its revised 2016-2017 Fiscal Year Assessment.

Given that Respondent timely objected to its 2016-2017 Fiscal Year Assessment, submitted a revised 2015 Assessment Report, and paid its revised 2016-2017 Fiscal Year Assessment, I&E is withdrawing the Complaint in the above-captioned matter.

If no party objects to the withdrawal of the Complaint within 20 days of service of this letter, this case will be marked closed.
