Diversified Commodities Inc. ("Respondent") has agreed to and satisfied the remedial measures sought by the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement ("I&E") of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission") in order to resolve the above-docketed complaint without litigation.

On September 12, 2018, Respondent filed a request to cancel its certificate of public convenience as a property carrier with the Commission. Consistent with the Commission's Motor Carrier Services and Enforcement Penalty Guidelines, no civil penalty was sought by I&E regarding the allegations that Respondent violated Sections 501(c) and 1501 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. §§ 501(c), 1501, for failing to undergo a safety fitness review.

Accordingly, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.24(a), I&E files this letter to certify that the above-docketed proceeding has been satisfied and should be marked closed. Should you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
