RE: Letter Petition of Reliant Energy Northeast LLC dba NRG Home and NRG Business ("REN") for Continuation of 5% Reduction in Security Requirements; Docket No. A-2010-2192350

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Please accept this Letter Petition on behalf of Reliant Energy Northeast LLC dba NRG Home and NRG Business ("REN") to renew its required level of financial security at the reduced level of 5%. This request is made pursuant to the Commission's Bond Reduction Order¹ and is being submitted at least 90 days prior to the expiration date of REN's current security. REN's current required level of financial security was initially approved by the Commission through its Secretarial Letter dated December 15, 2015. The reduction to 5% was continued by the Commission through Secretarial Letters dated September 29, 2016 and October 16, 2017.

Please find the following information in support of REN's request:

- 1) REN's gross receipts in Pennsylvania for the four most-recent quarters attached hereto as Appendix A (**CONFIDENTIAL**);
- 2) REN is current with its tax liabilities to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and is providing (a) proof of its prepaid gross receipts taxes toward its estimated revenues for the current year and (b) a Tax Status Letter from the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue, which are both attached hereto as Appendix B (**CONFIDENTIAL**); and
- 3) REN's Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards compliance data is attached hereto as Appendix C (**CONFIDENTIAL**).

Please note that the confidential attachments to this Letter Petition are being provided to the Commission under seal and it is requested that they be maintained in a non-public folder.


