Dear Judge Watson,

A Petition for Extension of Time in regard to the *Amended Preliminary Objections* and *Amended Answer and New Matter of West Penn Power Company* for E-Filing in the above case was *E-Filed* on August 30, 2018. No objections were made by West Penn Power/First Energy. Please grant my request as soon as possible as I am under extreme hardship.

Due to the continuing flooding in our basement, I am requesting an extension of time as the demand on my time is extreme. We are in the process of basement excavation and repairs. New drains need to replace the old clogged drains to shunt water away from the basement to ensure a safe place to live for me and my family. I am also taking care of my 88-year-old mother who has dementia, and I also take care of my granddaughter whose mother is a full-time medical student and son-in-law who is employed full time. I also work as a Registered Nurse at a local long-term acute care hospital.

Under the circumstances, I am petitioning for an Extension of Time in the amount of 100 days, as the ordinary time constraints are an extreme hardship on me. Also, the attorney for First Energy Corp. and West Penn Power Company ignored Judge Watson's order from the document titled "INTERIM ORDER GRANTING IN PART COMPLAINANT'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO REPLY TO RESPONDENT'S ANSWER AND NEW MATTER AND PRELIMINARY OBJECTIONS" dated August 7, 2018 with specifications of due dates pertaining to the Amended Formal Complaint. The attorney referenced the original ten (10) days and twenty (20) days for the Amended Preliminary Objections of West Penn Power Company and Amended Answer and New Matter of West Penn Power Company respectively.

Please consider my request favorably. Thank you.
