

7. FINANCIAL FITNESS

This is because Statistical Energy LLC proposes acting as a broker in Pennsylvania and does not take title to the gas in such a natural gas brokerage role. Since none of the NGDC's require a bond or some other form of security, no additional bonding paperwork is being submitted as part of this application.

 - On January 25, 2018, Statistical Energy LLC became a limited liability partnership, by allowing two additional partners, Michael Jackson and Ronald Cantlie, to purchase an ownership percentage in Statistical Energy LLC. The 2018 tax documents which will be filed with the IRS are a Schedule C for January 1, 2018 to January 24, 2018 and K-1's for January 25, 2018 to December 31, 2018.




