- c. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: Applicant agrees to provide the following information to the Commission or the Department of Revenue, as appropriate:
  - Retail Electricity Choice Activity Reports: The regulations at 52 Pa. Code §§ 54.201--54.204 require that all active EGSs report sales activity information. An EGS will file an annual report reporting for customer groups defined by annual usage. Reports must be filed using the appropriate report form that may be obtained from the PUC's Secretary's Bureau or the forms officer, or may be down-loaded from the PUC's internet web site.
  - Reports of Gross Receipts: Applicant shall report its Pennsylvania intrastate gross receipts to the Commission on a quarterly and year to date basis no later than 30 days following the end of the quarter.
  - The Treasurer or other appropriate officer of Applicant shall transmit to the Department of Revenue by March 15, an annual report, and under oath or affirmation, of the amount of gross receipts received by Applicant during the prior calendar year.
  - Net Metering Reports: Applicant shall be responsible to report any Net Metering per the Standards on <a href="http://www.puc.pa.gov/consumer-info/electricity/alternative-energy.aspx">http://www.puc.pa.gov/consumer-info/electricity/alternative-energy.aspx</a>. Scroll down to the Net Metering Standards Section.
  - Applicant shall report to the Commission the percentages of total electricity supplied by each fuel source on an annual basis per 52 Pa. Code § 54.39(d).
  - Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.



### Confident Customer Care

#### Why is Confidence Important and how do I convey it?

#### Why is it important to convey confidence when speaking with someone?

- Sounding confident on the phone makes for a more effective and productive conversation with your customer.
- This means that the customer will be more likely to:
  - O Trust the information you are giving out.
  - O Desire to work with you and hear what you are saying.
  - O Trust your ability to resolve their issue.

People make all sorts of snap judgments when hearing your voice. Your tone, pitch, pace, and inflection conveys all sorts of meaning.

#### How can I sound Confident on the phone?

Sounding confident will require that we make some adjustments to our speech pattern. We'll need to eliminate words and verbal cues that might make a customer feel that you are less than sure of the information you are giving out.

Some common verbal cues and words you can try to eliminate from your speech are:

- Saying 'um' and 'ah' more often than you should
- Using "Filler Words" that can make you sound unsure or immature, such as:
  - o "Like"
  - o "Sort Of"
  - o "I believe"
  - o "You Know"
- Raising the pitch of your voice at the end of a statement (as if you were asking a question). Doing this makes an individual sound:
  - o Unsure of the information being provided
  - o Unprofessional
- Speaking constantly in the same tone of voice, which can make you sound boring, tired, and uninterested.

Making an effort to replace those verbal cues with language and intonations that express a level of confidence on the phone will not only set your customer at ease, but also convey that you are capable of solving their problem.



You may want to think about the following points when assessing how to convey certain pieces of information:

- People respond positively to words that are active rather than passive.
  - o It's the subtle difference between saying "I Can" and "I Will"
  - o Think of the passive catch-all, "Let me see what I can do", which sets the customer's expectations somewhere between low and zero.
  - O Avoid using words that are non-committal, like saying "I may be able to help you with that."
  - O Changing that to "I'm delighted to help" let's a customer know that you actually want to assist them.
  - O Here are some more examples of positive words that you can use to replace vague language:
    - Delighted
    - Absolutely
    - Pleasure
    - Happy
    - Yes
- Delivering information in a cheerful, upbeat, and <u>natural</u> manner.
  - o A confident person is a person who is certain and looks forward to helping.
  - o Be sure to express your certainty about the information you're giving, while maintaining an upbeat attitude on the phone.


#### Things to Remember:

- Don't rely on forced or scripted language when you are connecting with a person on the phone.
- Make sure your customer knows they are talking to a <u>REAL</u> person, who is both
  confident in their ability to assist the customer, as well as genuinely glad for the
  opportunity to be of assistance.
- In the event a customer asks to speak with a team lead or supervisor, let them know that you are capable of handling their concern but will certainly escalate the call if you are unable to satisfactorily resolve their concern.



### Customer Care Communication

#### The 4 C's of Call Center Communication



#### In Customer Care we are required to effectively communicate with customers.

While what we communicate (topics and content) can vary, the way in which we release and collect information from a customer must follow some simple guidelines to ensure effective communications with our customers. When talking with a customer, it is imperative that we conduct ourselves in a way that allows us to be easily understood.

Let's discuss the **4 C's of Communication**, and how they can improve our day-to-day interactions with Customers and Co-Workers alike.

#### C#1: Comprehension

Within the first few moments of a call or conversation, it's likely you will get a feeling of the comprehension level of the person you are assisting.

Listening to the information provided to you by a customer, and the manner in which the information is relayed will be key in helping you decipher a customer's communication style.



Once you know what style of communication your customer prefers, you'll be better able to prepared to communicate with them.

Some Customer Communication Styles are listed below:

• **Assertive** – This person will possess a medium pitch, speed, and volume in their conversation. They are looking to achieve goals without hurting anyone else, and are protective of their own rights, while respectful of another person's.

This individual will ask questions directly, make choices, and take responsibility for those choices.

#### **Example Comment:**

"Can you please explain to me why I was billed for a medium plan when I signed up for a small plan?"

 Aggressive – This individual is focused on winning. They may feel as though their needs are more important than the needs of others. The customer who uses this communication style may have a loud tone of voice, and may use language that is demanding or abrasive. They can escalate easily to using language that is belligerent or explosive.

#### Example Comment:

"I have been ripped off over the years with high rates - I hope you guys aren't going to rip me off too!"

• Passive-Aggressive – Customers who use this style of communication often use language that is sarcastic and can be interpreted as patronizing. This person will often sulk in their current state and complain without clearly indicating that they looking or resolution of an issue.

#### **Example Comment:**

"I hope your company isn't going to charge me whatever you want?"

• **Submissive** – When dealing with a person who uses this communication style, you will find that they are apologetic, avoiding confrontation, and have a tendency to blame others for events.

#### Example Comment:

"You see no one ever explained to me that this is how it works, and my wife signed us up for this."

• Manipulative – This individual may be trying to influence or control the outcome of a conversation to their own advantage. They will ask indirectly for something, trying to make others feel sorry for them.

"I didn't have time to enroll with you guys, so I ended up on a high renewal rate. I wish your website was easier to find."

Once we have an understanding of how the individual we are attempting to service communicates, we'll be better able to extract from them the rest of the information what we need to understand in order to assist them.


PLEASE NOTE:

Just because a Customer uses a specific style of communication, does not mean that the Customer Care Representative should use a similar style. We should always aim to be **Assertive** in our communications with the customer—being completely direct and clear, in a respectful manner.

#### C # 2: Care

We should always take into consideration the way in which we are conveying sounds to our caller, and seek to express information in such a way that the customer feels we are empathetic and genuinely interested in their issue or question.

The best way we can express this type of consideration for their concern is by using some of the skills listed below:



- Active Listening Do not interrupt or speak over a Customer. If you hear a Customer trying to speak, stop speaking, and allow them communicate their thought. Additionally, we should never allow any dead air throughout a conversation, as this gives the customer the idea that you are not listening and thereby not interested in the information they are trying to give to you.
- Acknowledgement If a Customer gives you a piece of information, acknowledge it, but do not rush the communication in the hopes they'll get to more "important" information. Remember, when it comes to a Customer, everything they have to say is important!

### **C # 3: Context**

Context is defined as the set of circumstances or facts that surround a particular event. Setting a Context for information applies to what we ask for from a customer.



#### For Example:

• If I am asking a Customer for a copy of their bill, setting context might include letting them know that in order to assist them with resolving their issue, I require a copy of their bill.

#### Example:

"Because we are unable to read your uploaded bill, would you be willing to email me a copy of the bill so I may adjust the usage figures on your account which will resolve the matter."

• If I am asking a Customer with only a couple of months of usage for their home's square footage and heating source, I should prepare them by letting them know WHY I am asking for these details.

"I see that your uploaded bill reflects only Jan through March usage. To evaluate and enroll you on the correct plan, I need to estimate your annual usage. I am able to do that if I know the size of your home and type of heat used."

The goal is to avoid the question "Why" from a Customer. If I provide you with pertinent details up front, it is less likely that you will wonder why I need specific information from you.

#### C # 4: Conciseness

To be concise is to express a wealth of information in a brief form; releasing information with clarity and crispness.

Clear & Concise



The normal tendency for us as human beings is to tune out things that we don't find interesting or don't feel is applicable to us. In Customer Care we have the benefit of knowing and practicing skills that can help us pay attention, but our customers are not always in the same boat. If we ramble or "beat around the bush" when providing information, customers will not really pay attention, and you will lose your opportunity to delight and retain customers.

What can we do to make sure we have a customer's attention? Be Concise!

Below are some things we can do when evaluating information we are ready to release in order to ensure it is concise.

- Use key "Grabber" words that will gain the attention of the customer, such as:
  - o "I have good news for you!"
  - o "This is what I am able to do for you now"
  - o "We have a great opportunity for you to receive automatic savings!"

o "I have a plan offering that is 4 cents below your utility, and the plan also includes a \$50 gift card reward!"

The key is to get your customer's attention then release important details. Don't spend time explaining a plan details to a customer who is NOT paying attention. Use your "Grabber" comments, then wait for a response from a customer before laying out specifics.

- Use your voice to capture your audience.
  - o If you don't sound excited about auto-switching, your customer will not be interested in it either.
  - o Changing the pitch/tone of your voice will draw attention to what you are saying, and can also be an effective "*Grabber*" technique.

What we're looking to do is to not only get, but **KEEP** your customer's full attention. You may need to change not only **WHAT** you say, but **HOW** you say it in order to maintain the undivided attention of your caller.

- Avoid using "Company Jargon" or language referring to internal processes.
  - O Don't waste time giving your customer details that don't apply to them directly. Your customer doesn't need to know that we submit an enrollment via a spreadsheet that gets processed by the supplier. These details are sometime confusing for the customer.

#### The bottom line is this:

- A Confused Customer is an Unhappy Customer! And an unhappy customer often turns into either an Angry Customer, or worse still—an EX-Customer! Don't run the risk of confusing a customer!

#### Stick to the facts!

Don't intermingle your own opinions or feelings about a certain product or
offering to a customer. Stick to approved talking points, and if you're unsure
or need assistance in highlighting the features/benefits of a product – ASK
FOR HELP.

#### - Be Clear!

O Say what you mean and mean what you say! Before responding to a Customer, ask yourself two questions:

"Does this information matter to my customer?"

"Should this information matter to my customer?"

If the answer is YES to either question, be clear with the customer, letting them know exactly what is necessary in a way that is CLEAR and CONCISE!
