The only reason we need a license in PA is because some of our customers whom we served for many years purchased properties in PA and would like us to negotiate their energy contracts the same way we do in other parts of the country for other properties they won. We will not be marketing door to door in PA. We will not be utilizing any type of call center to solicit customers. We plan to continue to grow through word of mouth/referral marketing.
