
U-1. The filing's cover page avers the agreement meets the exemption requirements under 66 Pa. C.S. § 1102(a)(3)(ii)(A). However, the filing does not appear to meet the broader 66 Pa. C.S. § 1102(a)(3)(ii) exemption requirement since the agreement's \$42,736 purchase price exceeds the \$5,000 limit in the case of personality as specified in 66 Pa. C.S. § 1102(a)(3)(ii)(B). Please reconfirm why the filing does not require 66 Pa. C.S. § 1102(a)(3) approval.

Response: After further review, Pennsylvania American Water confirms that the filing meets the exemption requirement under 66 Pa. C.S. § 1102(a)(3)(iii).
