## 7. FINANCIAL FITNESS

### CRITICAL BONDING NOTES:

If Applicant's security instrument is not continuous, Applicant **MUST** submit a Rider, Amendment, or Continuation Certificate annually based on the expiration date of its security instrument.

- Reports of Gross Receipts: Applicant shall report its Pennsylvania intrastate gross receipts to the Commission on a quarterly and year to date basis no later than 30 days following the end of the quarter.
- The Treasurer or other appropriate officer of Applicant shall transmit to the Department of Revenue by March 15, an annual report, and under oath or affirmation, of the amount of gross receipts received by Applicant during the prior calendar year.
- Net Metering Reports: Applicant shall be responsible to report any Net Metering per the Standards on [http://www.puc.pa.gov/consumer\\_info/electricity/alternative\\_energy.aspx](http://www.puc.pa.gov/consumer_info/electricity/alternative_energy.aspx). Scroll down to the Net Metering Standards Section.
- Applicant shall report to the Commission the percentages of total electricity supplied by each fuel source on an annual basis per 52 Pa. Code § 54.39(d).
- Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.







1. Applicant's previous experience in the electricity industry:

Robindale Retail Power Services, LLC's (RRPS) owners have a substantial amount of experience in the wholesale generation market that was gained through the ownership of three generation companies; Sunbury Generation LP (41 MW of peaking fuel oil fired generation), Seward Generation, LLC (525 MW waste coal fired generation facility) and Ebensburg Power Company (50 MW waste coal fired generation facility).

RRPS has retained Kinect Energy to help navigate the retail electricity market in the state of Pennsylvania. Kinect Energy's experience in the retail electricity market includes: advisory, sourcing and contract negotiation services to multiple retail sites in Pennsylvania as well to hundreds of other sites across the United States, Canada and Mexico. These sites include commercial facilities, school districts, manufacturers, and larger industrials. Usage from these sites range from 100KW up to 45MW.

2. Summary and proof of licenses as a supplier of electric services in other states or jurisdiction:

RRPS does not currently have a license in other states or jurisdictions.

3. Type of customers and number of customers Applicant currently serves in other jurisdictions:

None

4. Staffing structure and numbers as well as employee training commitments:

Initially, Nicholas Gingrich (contact information provided in section 1(e)) will be the primary contact and developer of RRPS. Nicholas will work closely with Kinect Energy to market the power provided by the generation assets referenced above and will report to the Officers listed in Schedule 8E.

Kinect Energy currently has over 100 staff members with multiple offices in the US. In total, 16 Kinect Energy retail electric team members will work with RRPS to market the power provided by the generation assets. The staff members have multiple year of experience operating within retail electricity choice states like Pennsylvania. Members of the staff have certifications including PJM generator

operator, NERC system operator and Series 3 with the Nation Futures Association.

5. Business plans for operations within the Commonwealth:

As an affiliate of numerous PA companies as described in Schedule 3A, as well as power generation assets described above, RRPS will market its power generation to end use retail electricity customers in the Commonwealth of PA. The initial customers are going to be some of the affiliate customers referenced in Schedule 3A. RRPS will also market power to Robindale Energy Service's coal customers, some of which have significant electrical loads in the steel industry. RRPS will also make use of Kinect Energy's contacts when appropriate. The marketing effort will rely mainly on existing contacts as well as word of mouth.

Sunbury Generation LP, Seward Generation LLC and Ebensburg Power Company all have PJM membership. RRPS will also become a PJM member. It is expected that this process will be completed over the coming couple months.
