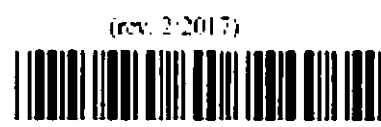

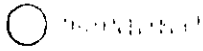

OPERATING AGREEMENT OF Adveen Energy LLC

This Operating Agreement is made and adopted effective on 8/8/2018 by Adveen Energy, LLC, a limited liability company organized under the laws of Pennsylvania (the Company) and Brian Bodine and Nick Miller, its members (each a Member, together the Members).

ARTICLE I - ORGANIZATION

Section 1.1 – Company Formation and Duration. The Company has been organized as a limited liability company managed by its members. The Company shall commence on the date of filing of the Articles of Organization and shall exist until the Company dissolves and its affairs are wound up in accordance with this Operating Agreement or applicable law.

Section 1.2 – Members and LLC Units. “LLC Units” or “Units” means measures of ownership in the LLC. The ownership of the Company shall consist of Units with equal rights for all purposes under this Operating Agreement. “LLC Unit Percentage” means, with respect to a Member, the percentage derived by dividing number of LLC Units held by such Member by the total number of LLC Units held by all Members and, thereafter, multiplying the resulting fraction by 100 to arrive at a percentage.

Section 1.3 – Table of Members, LLC Units, and LLC Unit Percentages. The Members of the Company are set forth below, alongside the number of LLC Units and the LLC Unit Percentage for each Member. Any time there is a change in the membership in the Company (for example, admission of a new member, withdrawal of a member, issuance of new LLC Units, etc.), the Company shall create an updated table of Members, LLC Units, and LLC Unit Percentages, circulate a copy to all Members, and maintain a copy with the Company’s official records.

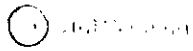

Section 1.4 – Books and Records. The Company shall maintain complete and accurate books and records of the Company’s business and affairs.

Section 1.5 – Amendment; Entire Agreement. This Operating Agreement may be amended at any time by a majority Vote in interest of LLC Units (as defined below), for any reason. This Operating Agreement, as may be amended, constitutes the entire agreement between the Members and Company with respect to the subject matter hereof.

ARTICLE II – MANAGEMENT AND VOTING

Section 2.1 – Member Management. The Company shall be managed solely by the Members, who may be known as and hold any title(s) approved by a majority Vote in interest of LLC Units.



Section 2.2 – Initial Responsibilities. All Members are jointly responsible for sales and marketing, managing relationships with suppliers and clients, maintaining an accurate database of clients, recruiting potential 1099 sales representative, managing W-2 employees, maintaining accurate records for the company and filing accurate and timely reports with the government. Nick Miller will be responsible for bill auditing, technical matters related to energy procurement, and energy efficiency consulting. Brian Bodine will be responsible for purchasing and hedging strategies, accounting, and finance.

Section 2.3 – Hiring of Employees. Hiring decisions for both W-2 employees and 1099 employees will be approved with a majority vote in interest of LLC Units as outlined in Section 2.4.

Section 2.4 – Voting. The affairs and business of the Company shall be decided by a Vote in interest of LLC Units. “Vote in interest of LLC Units” means a vote of the LLC Members in which each LLC Member shall have one vote per LLC Unit possessed; for example, a Member possessing 15 LLC Units would have 15 votes in interest. Unless another percentage is given elsewhere in this Operating Agreement or by applicable state law, all Member votes on any matter shall require an affirmative vote in interest by LLC Members of more than 50% of the outstanding total of LLC Units to pass or approve the motion, resolution, or otherwise take action by the Members (a majority Vote in interest of LLC Units).

Section 2.5 – Member Authority. The Members agree with the Company and each other that no Member, acting individually, shall have the power or authority to act on behalf of or bind the LLC, to authorize any action to be taken by the LLC, to act as agent for the LLC, or to incur any liability or expense on behalf of the LLC, unless the power or authority has been delegated to the Member by a written resolution duly adopted by the Members in accordance with the provisions of this article and then only to the extent expressly provided for in the resolution. The Members may adopt resolutions appointing one or more Members sign on behalf of the Company to acquire, encumber, or convey real or personal property from any source and through any means; engage in any financial transactions on behalf of the Company, including opening, maintaining, or closing accounts, borrowing money, or the like; entering into contracts on behalf of the Company; commence, prosecute, or defend any legal proceedings in the Company’s name; and carry on any other business or affairs of the Company not specifically provided herein, that is not in contravention of applicable law.

Section 2.4 – Indemnification. Unless otherwise provided by law, the Members are not liable for the acts, debts, or obligations of the Company. The Company shall indemnify, defend, and hold the each Member harmless from and against any losses, claims, costs, damages, and liabilities, including, without limitation, judgments, fines, amounts paid in settlement, and expenses incurred by each Member in any civil, criminal, or investigative proceeding in which the Member is involved or threatened to be involved by reason of the Member’s membership in or management of the Company.

ARTICLE III – CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Section 3.1 – Initial Capital Contributions. The Members have made or will make an initial contribution to the capital of the Company, as set forth in Company records.

Section 3.2 – Additional Capital Contributions by Members. The Members may, by majority Vote in interest of LLC Units, raise additional capital or by issuing additional LLC Units to existing members in exchange for capital contributions specified by resolution.



Section 3.3 – Additional Capital by Admission of New Members. The Members may, by majority Vote in interest of LLC Units, raise additional capital by issuing additional LLC Units to a newly admitted member in exchange for capital contributions or other in-kind contributions to the Company, specified by resolution and in accordance with Section 5.1.

ARTICLE IV – DISTRIBUTIONS

Section 4.1 – Allocations. Except as may be required by the Internal Revenue Code (Title 26 of the United States Code) or the Treasury Regulations (Title 26 of the Code of Federal Regulations) or this Operating Agreement, net profits, net losses, and other items of income, gain, loss, deduction and credit of the Company shall be allocated among the Members in proportion to each Member's LLC Unit Percentage.

Section 4.2 – Distributions. The Members, by resolution issued pursuant to this Operating Agreement, may make distributions to the Members from time to time in the total amount the Members deem appropriate. Such distributions shall be allocated among the Members in proportion to each Member's LLC Unit Percentage. No distribution shall be declared or made if, after making the distribution, the Company would not be able to pay its debts as they become due or the Company's total assets would be less than the sum of its total liabilities.

Section 4.3 – Commission Payments. Commission payments due to the Members will be 40% of the total value of the energy procurement contract to which their name is attributable, payable only after the company has been paid. There will be no up-front commission payments from the Company to its Members. Commission payments will be treated as minimum required distributions unless a commission distribution payment would result in a situation where the Company would not be able to pay its debts as they become due or the Company's total assets would be less than the sum of its total liabilities.

ARTICLE V – MEMBERSHIP CHANGES

Section 5.1 – New Members. The Members may by majority Vote in interest of LLC Units admit a new member in the Company and issue additional LLC Units to new members. Any new members shall, before being admitted and as a condition to admission, execute any document or documents required by the Company, agree to be and become a member of the Company, and agree to be bound by the terms of the Company Operating Agreement.

Section 5.2 – Transfers of LLC Units. The Member may voluntarily sell, transfer, assign, encumber, pledge, convey, or otherwise dispose of part or all of Member's membership interest, but only upon a majority Vote in interest of LLC Units allowing the transfer and admitting the new Member in accordance with Section 5.1, if the new Member does not already hold LLC Units in the Company.

Section 5.3 – Voluntary Withdrawal. Members shall have the unilateral right to withdraw at any time from the Company subject to the terms of this Operating Agreement and applicable law.

Section 5.4 – Death of a Member and Right of First Refusal. Upon the death of a member, the LLC units owned by the deceased member will lose their voting rights and be transferred to their estate or living family in accordance with applicable laws, but only after the company, with a majority vote in interest of



the remaining LLC units, declines its Right of First Refusal to purchase the LLC units at a price of 3 times EBIT (earnings before interest and taxes).

ARTICLE VI – NONDISCLOSURE & COMPETITION

Section 6.1 – Definition of Confidential Information. For purposes of this Agreement, "Confidential Information" shall include all information or material that has or could have commercial value or other utility in the business in which the Company is engaged.

Section 6.3 – Exclusions from Confidential Information. Member's obligations do not extend to information that is: (a) publicly known or subsequently becomes publicly known through no fault of the Member; (b) discovered or created by the Member before the effective date of this agreement; (c) learned by the Member through legitimate means other than from the operations or disclosure by the Company or its representatives; or (d) is disclosed by Member with prior written approval from the Company.

Section 6.2 – Obligations of Members. Members shall hold and maintain the Confidential Information in strictest confidence for the sole and exclusive benefit of the Company. Members shall carefully restrict access to Confidential Information to employees, contractors, and third parties as is reasonably required and shall require those persons to sign nondisclosure restrictions at least as protective as those in this Agreement. Members shall not, without prior written approval of the Company, use for the Member's own benefit, publish, copy, or otherwise disclose to others, or permit the use by others for their benefit or to the detriment of the Company, any Confidential Information.

Section 6.3 – Competition. Members are forbidden to own equity interest in firms that compete directly with the Company without first obtaining permission from the Company via a majority vote in LLC Units.

ARTICLE VII – DISSOLUTION

Section 7.1 – Dissolution. Upon a majority Vote in interest of LLC Units, the Company shall dissolve and its affairs shall be wound up. On dissolution, the Company shall cease carrying on its business and affairs and shall begin to wind them up. The Company shall complete the winding up as soon as practicable. On the winding up of the Company, its assets shall be distributed in a manner consistent with applicable law.

3. MARKET RESEARCH

3.1 Industry

The Energy industry covers the generation, distribution and sale of energy products. Adveen Energy will focus on the sale of electricity and natural gas. The industry is broken down into four main groups, utilities (power generators), suppliers, brokers, and consumers/clients. Electricity generators vary widely in the method of converting mechanical energy to electrical energy. Steam turbines, coal, nuclear, wind, and solar are all popular methods. Energy suppliers take title to the electricity and work to help distribute the energy to customers with the help of a broker. Brokers work with suppliers to negotiate on behalf of their clients and achieve the best solutions for their clients. Brokers can act as a sales force for suppliers, or they can act as consultants, covering a wide range of services including electricity procurement, energy efficiency, bill auditing, load curve analysis, and hedging strategies. Adveen energy plans to offer a full suite of services as a consultant to its customers. The fourth group is the clients, which include businesses of all sizes who would like to purchase power at the lowest risk adjusted rate possible.

Adveen Energy will work closely with several suppliers in order to quote competitive rates to customers. Brian Bodine has pre existing relationships with employees at energy suppliers including First Energy. Upon approval of PUC License to provide electric and natural gas services, Adveen Energy will contact Suppliers who may be interested in working with Adveen Energy in order to provide electric products.

3.2 Customers

Customers include medium to large size businesses. Businesses in our target market will use 200,000 kwh per year or more of electricity.

3.3 Competitors

There is approximately 300 licensed brokers competing within the commonwealth of PA. Most brokers are very small. Adveen Energy's founders bring a unique set of skills that will differentiate them from the competition.

3.4 Competitive Advantage

Brian Bodine worked at one of the largest brokers in PA, OnDemand Energy. OnDemand upgraded to a contract management database, but for most of its existence, OnDemand used excel as a customer database. Excel remains the industry standard for customer databases. Adveen Energy plans on expanding the excel model by using Microsoft Access to organize and analyze customer data.

Both founders of Adveen Energy LLC are competent at analyzing and manipulating large data

sets. Nick Miller, as part of his engineering program at Penn State, took classes on thermodynamics, HVAC, and energy efficiency. His expertise with energy efficiency will create value for Adveen Energy's clients.

Brian Bodine is an MBA student at the Tepper School of Business, which will grant Adveen Energy access to a network of 15,000 Tepper Alumni. In addition, Brian will continue to be trained in management strategies, data analytics, accounting, and finance, which will provide a benefit to the operations of this company in the long term. Brian has worked in finance at Northwestern Mutual and at MFA Wealth, and is an expert at financial hedging strategies. Both Nick and Brian are competent at analyzing markets and will be able to effectively recommend risk management and hedging strategies to Adveen Energy's clients based on market research and an understanding of each individual client's risk tolerance. In order to analyze clients, Adveen Energy LLC will use the Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory's "Methods for Analyzing Electric Load Shape and its Variability" and "Electric Load Shape Benchmarking for Small- and Medium-Sized Commercial Buildings." In order to hedge load risk and spot price risk, Adveen Energy LLC will use risk management methods that CEO Brian Bodine learned at the Tepper School of Business with additional insights based on Princeton University's research paper entitled "A MODEL FOR HEDGING LOAD AND PRICE RISK IN THE TEXAS ELECTRICITY MARKET."

Adveen Energy LLC is developing a proprietary risk assessment tool to aid in analyzing client risk tolerance. Similar to the questionnaires used in the finance industry, Adveen Energy's risk assessment tool will be a good starting point to better understand client needs, but it will not replace face to face interaction.

Adveen Energy's Founders have a strong understanding of the tradeoffs between fixed price procurement, blended purchasing, and index (floating rate) procurement, as well as analyzing customer load shapes to determine appropriate tariffs. They use a strong analytical framework to measure risk and volatility, with an unrelenting focus on data analytics to help our customers achieve the best risk adjusted pricing for their energy needs.

3.5 Regulation

4. PRODUCT/SERVICE LINE

4.1 Product or Service

Adveen Energy LLC will provide electricity procurement services, including negotiating with suppliers on behalf of clients and implementing risk management strategies to hedge against volatility in the electricity market.

4.2 Pricing Structure

Pricing is fixed at the time of contract. Pricing is based on the rate that we are able to negotiate with the supplier, and the involvement and complexity of the hedging strategy required by the client, as well as ancillary consulting services provided. Adveen Energy LLC will receive compensation as accrued by the supplier, calculated as the fee per Kilowatt hour multiplied by the amount of Kilowatt hours used by the client.

Target fee range is .002 cents per Kwh used and up. Fixed fees for larger users, and fees below .002 cents per Kwh will also be considered on a case by case basis.

4.3 Product/Service Life Cycle

Electricity is a commodity and is therefore immune to the life cycle of normal consumer products.

From the perspective of electricity and natural gas brokers, there has been an influx of brokers since rate caps expired in 2010. Based on our market analysis, the broker business model remains in the growth stage. This means there is plenty of room to compete with other broker's on price, customer service, and the creativity of our solutions.

In 1996, Pennsylvania enacted House Bill 1509, known commonly as the Electricity Generation Customer Choice and Competition Act. Steady deregulation occurred over the next decade and a half. In 2010 and 2011, rate caps expired across many utilities, leaving energy procurement to the whims of an open market and opening the door for full service brokerages to shine. This opportunity is still alive and well. Adveen Energy LLC plans to integrate itself into the Pennsylvania energy market in order to offer creative solutions and professional service to our customers.

5. MARKETING & SALES

5.1 Growth Strategy

We plan on growing organically by requesting referrals from initial clients and hiring 1099 sales reps. Initial clients will be relational based.

Other than a website and business cards, we do not plan on investing in marketing through the end of 2019.



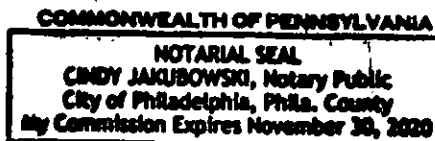


