
Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On behalf of Rasier-PA LLC ("Rasier"), enclosed is a check for fifty dollars (\$50.00). This is the fine amount requested by the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement to terminate further proceedings in connection with the above-captioned Complaint ("Complaint"). The Complaint alleges that Rasier is subject to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("PaPUC") jurisdiction pursuant to a certificate of public convenience granted to Rasier at Docket No. A-2016-2580821 on January 26, 2017, authorizing the transportation of persons for compensation in Transportation Network Company ("TNC") service. In addition, the Complaint alleges that Rasier is in violation of 66 Pa. C.A. § 2605(b)(8), governing the marking of vehicles used in TNC service.

Rasier denies that it operates in Pennsylvania pursuant to a certificate of public convenience. Rasier is a TNC operating in Pennsylvania pursuant to a license issued by this Commission under Chapter 26 of the Public Utility Code. Nevertheless, Rasier does not contest payment of the requested fine and is forwarding this amount in order to resolve and close this Complaint.
