Enclosed for review and approval in accordance with Section 507 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 507 and 52 Pa. Code § 3.101, is a Right of Way agreement dated November 1, 2018 between Duquesne Light Company and the Township of Mt. Lebanon. The Township of Mt. Lebanon granted to Duquesne Light Company a right of way on its property situated on Cedar Boulevard in the Township of Mt. Lebanon, Allegheny County which provides the right to erect, install, use, own, operate, maintain, repair, renew and remove one anchor together with the guy wires and other apparatus. No monetary compensation was granted to the Township of Mt. Lebanon for this easement.

**RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT**

The undersigned Grantor, **TOWNSHIP OF MT. LEBANON**, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant unto Duquesne Light Company, its successors and assigns, for providing, transmitting and/or distributing electric and/or communications services for any and all purposes, the right, privilege and authority to erect, install, use, own, operate, maintain, repair, renew and finally remove an electric line, consisting of **four (4) poles (#372656 - item 1, #372658 - item 5, #341563 - item 7 & #341564 - item 8)**, together with crossarms, cables, wires, **three (3) anchors (attached to poles #372656 - item 1, #372658 - item 5 & 341564 - item 8)**, guys and other fixtures and apparatus thereto belonging, upon, over, under, along, across and through Grantors lands, fronting on **Cedar Boulevard**, situate in **Mt. Lebanon Township, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania**, having Tax I.D.'s 252-A-220 and 193-P-190, and shown on Duquesne Light Company Drawing No. **465975**, a copy of which has been attached hereto and made a part hereof. Duquesne Light Company shall also have the following rights: to trim or remove any trees or shrubbery which, at any time or times, may interfere or threaten to interfere with the erection, installation, use, operation, maintenance, repair, renewal or removal of the electric line; to enter upon the land at any time for such purposes; to permit others to attach crossarms, cables, wires and related apparatus, and to use the poles and apparatus erected hereunder; and to sell, assign, lease or otherwise transfer any or all of the rights hereunder.

Utility shall file a copy of this Agreement with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission as required by Title 66, Section 507 of the Public Utility Code, and this Agreement shall become effective in accordance therewith.

Intending to be legally bound the Grantor has executed this agreement this 15<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2018.
