





MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.103 and 5.61, Respondent Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light” or the “Company”), by and through its attorney, Emily M. Farah, files this Motion to Consolidate:

1. On or about October 19, 2018 Complainant HFT Holdings, Inc. (“Complainant”) filed two formal complaints (collectively, “Complaints”) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“PUC” or “Commission”) against Duquesne Light.
2. The formal complaint identified by docket number C-2018-3005529 listed Duquesne Light Account Number [REDACTED] which is associated with 1910 Cochran Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15220 (“Manor Oak I”).
3. The formal complaint identified by docket number C-2018-3005532 listed Duquesne Light Account Number [REDACTED] which is also associated with 1910 Cochran Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15220 (“Manor Oak II”).
4. The Complaints involve the same parties and appear to make substantially similar allegations concerning electric service at Manor Oak I and Manor Oak II.
5. To the extent a hearing is required, Duquesne Light expects the witnesses for both parties to be the same in both matters.
6. Complainant is represented by the same counsel in both matters.
7. Consolidating these Complaints would not prejudice either party.


