Kinect Energy, Inc. from time to time works with third party suppliers to develop supply products for small commercial and residential accounts that could be associated with Kinect Energy, Inc. 's commercial and industrial customers. For residential customers the sole option for enrollment is directly through an online Suppliers portal using Supplier's normal residential contract procedures and language.

For provision of our services, Kinect Energy, Inc. receives a fee from the natural gas supplier who ultimately contracts with the customer. Thereafter, the contractual relationship is strictly between the customer and the natural gas supplier. Although the contractual relationship for natural gas supply is ultimately between the customer and the supplier, Kinect Energy, Inc. is committed to its customers to guide them through the procurement process and consult with them to clarify the pricing, terms, conditions, switching rules etc. that are part of the supplier(s) contract(s). All other terms, rules, disclosures, billing issues, and other customer information that is inherently the supplier(s) responsibility are not duplicated by Kinect Energy, Inc. However, Kinect Energy, Inc. will consult with and assist the customer as required with any supplier specific issues.






