The public entrusts our public servants to protect the community. I am requesting that the PA PUC to further investigate this smart meter technology because you have the power, the duty and responsibility to correct this problem of concerns that I and I am sure others have with smart meter technology. The most important right that all people have - is the power to forgive.

Please take the time to watch the documentary "Take Back Your Power 2017 (Official) - smart meter documentary" by Josh del Sol and "The Truth About 5G" by InPower Movement which are all provided on youtube to stream and to further educate yourselves as I have done. Smart meters are not safe, reliable, accurate, secure, private, nor green.

Please be advised and the power company have been notified prior to my formal complaint, that I do not consent to the installation of the smart meter technology or any other type of surveillance/digital electronic type meter, including electrical equipment that is the home owners property used to support smart meter. This is wrong and I will not permit this to occur because it is my god-given unalienable natural right under the protection of cause.

I have found no evidence that any person or persons have the authority to install by force, smart meter on my private property and/or shut off my power because I will not comply with Act-129. Statues under the color of law are and always have been voluntary.

The power company may have been required by the PA PUC to install smart meters, but no person or persons has jurisdiction to force such action upon anyone if they reject/forbid the use of smart meter technology. If it is your judgment that the PA PUC and/or the power company has the authority to shut off my power because I will not comply with the installation smart meter technology, then I am requesting that you delay shut-off until after Apr. 2018 because I have no way to safely heat my home at this time. Please include a 10-day written notice prior to shut off.

The intent to my complaint was as follows:

- Continue the use of my current analog meter until fault
- Continued use of a electromechanical analog meter only
- Terminate all charges associated with smart meter device

Due to continued health reasons, which are interfering with my ability to continue with proceeding, I wish to withdrawal my formal complaint Docket no. C-2018-3001720. Please notify all parties involved. Please respond in writing to this notice. Thank you for your time in this matter.

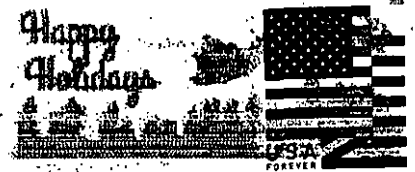
