Dear Judge Jones:

Please be advised that at this time I wish to dismiss the above referenced case as PECO has satisfied the two issues for which I brought the case forth to begin with.

To reiterate the two arguments were as follows:

1. PECO continued to bill my account the PUC Agreement amount despite the fact that the entire PUC Amount due was paid off in full in the month's prior.
2. PECO denied my application for the CAP program.

I am pleased to announce that after the October 22, 2018 hearing date; **PECO has removed the PUC Agreement amount from their charges against my account invoices** as the entire PUC Agreement had been completely satisfied in full previously, and PECO has also since then **APPROVED MY APPLICATION FOR THE CAP PROGRAM** reduced rates as I was advised last week by PECO. Therefore, under these circumstances, I wish to withdraw my complaint at this time.

I am pleased with the favorable outcomes listed above. My only regret is that PECO did not take these actions prior to the October 22, 2018 hearing date.
