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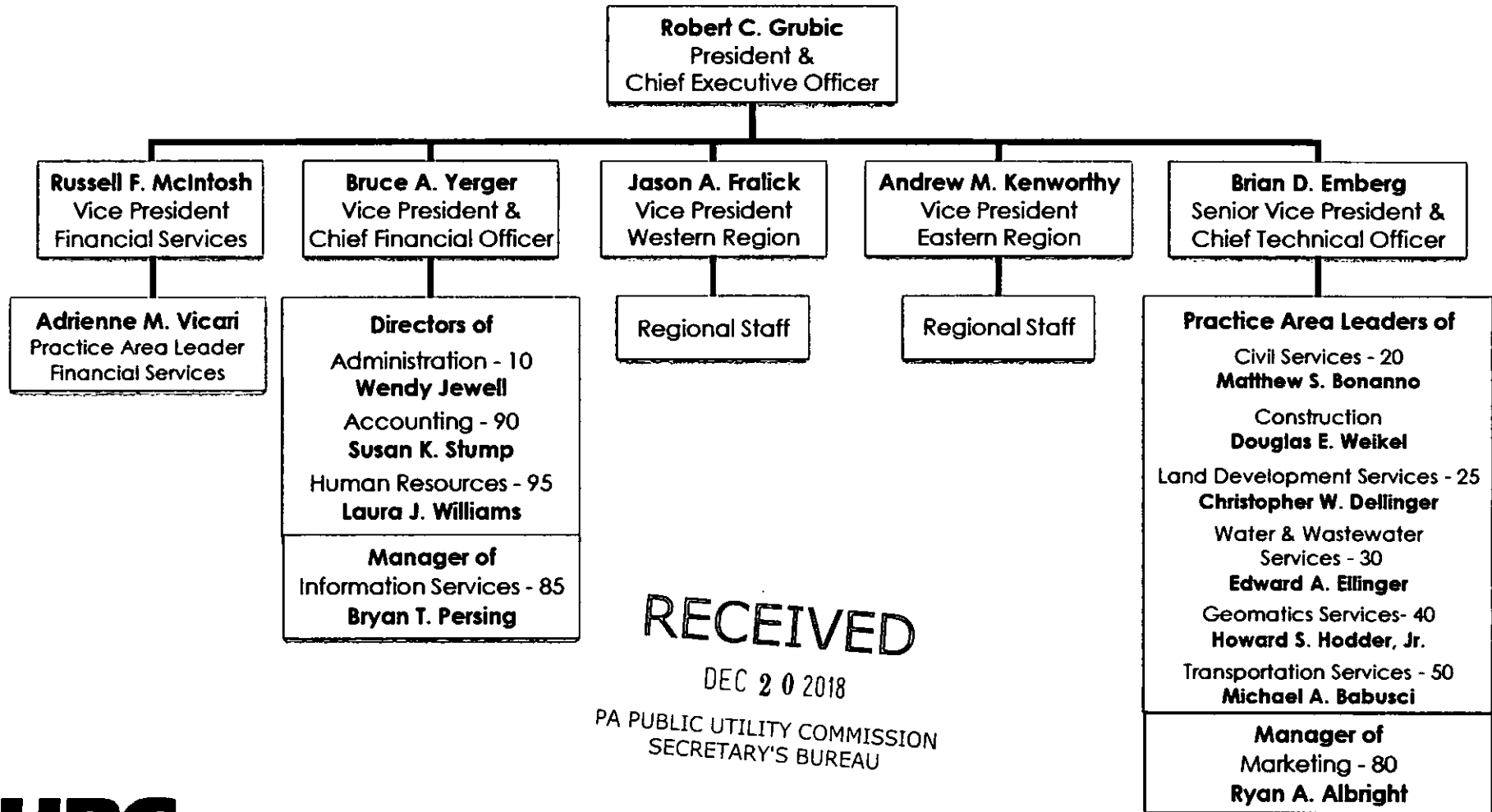

(Current – Until January 1, 2019)



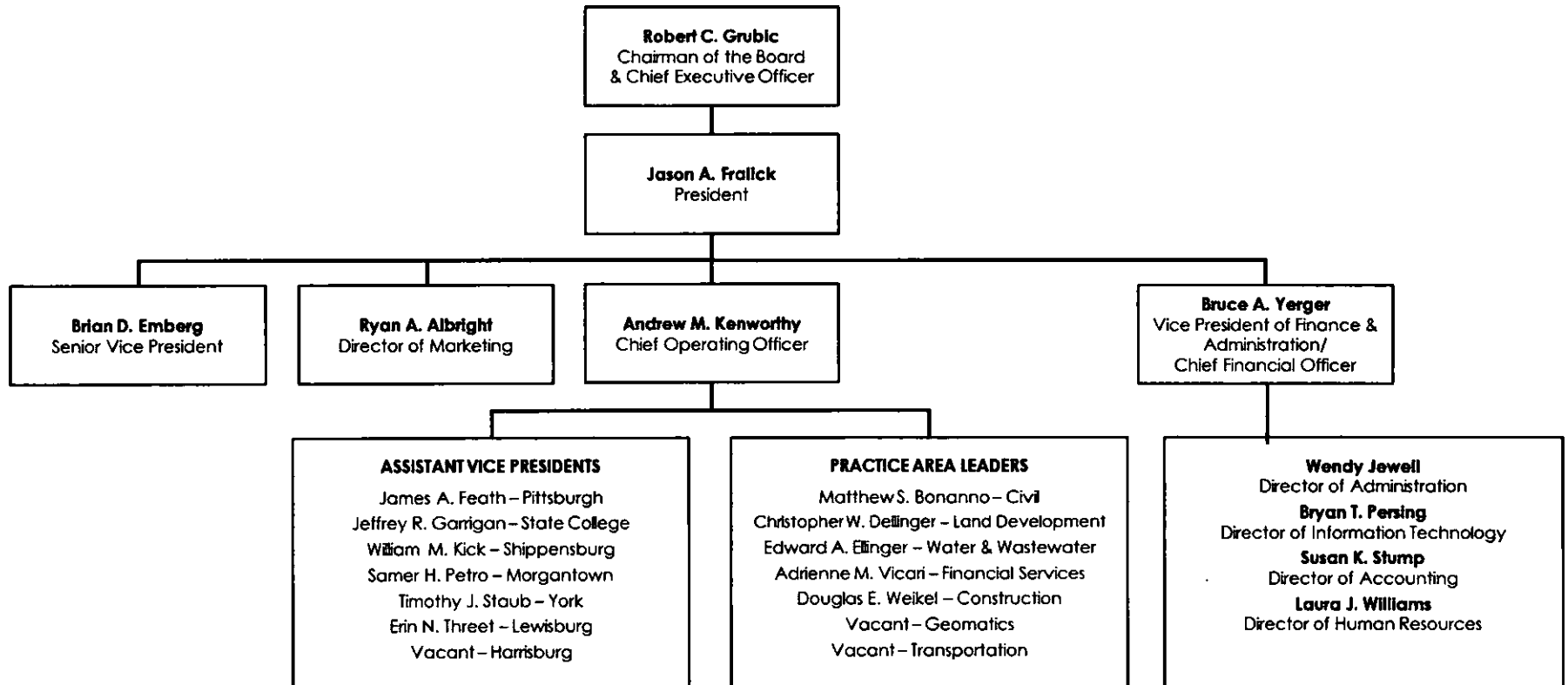
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Herbert, Rowland & Grubic, Inc. Organizational Reporting Structure

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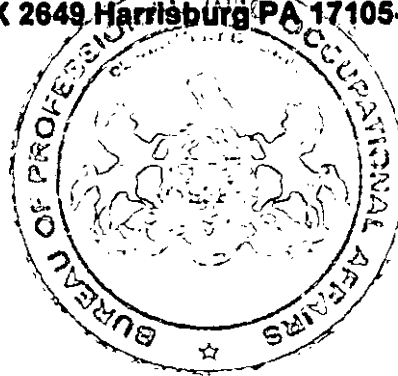
