Dear Judge Watson:

On October 16, 2018, Metropolitan Edison Company (“Met-Ed” or the “Company”) filed a Motion to Dismiss due to the Complainant’s repeated failure to respond to discovery, despite an order by Your Honor granting the Company’s earlier Motion to Compel. On December 6, 2018, Your Honor issued an Interim Order setting procedural schedule, establishing various compliance deadlines, including the submission of notifications of all witnesses expected to be presented at hearing in this matter. On December 7, 2018, Your Honor issued an Interim Order holding the Company’s Motion to Dismiss in abeyance until December 27, 2018, by which date the Complainant must respond to the outstanding discovery requests, and requiring the parties to submit a status report regarding compliance with the deadlines set in this matter no later than January 4, 2019. As the result of an inadvertent oversight, on January 3, 2019, the Company submitted its notification of proposed witnesses to be presented in this proceeding. To date, the Company has not received notice of any witnesses to be presented by the Complainant, nor has Met-Ed received responses to the discovery requests it initially issued on August 8, 2018.
