As noted in your review, the focus of my Complaint was Duquesne Light's proposal for a rate increase. Specifically, my Complaint maintained that any rate increase for Duquesne Light should be based on a "revised proposal (from Duquesne Light) that includes a constructive environmental vision for the future – a vision enhancing the environment rather than degrading it".
