**WRITTEN REQUEST FOR CONVERSION OF JANUARY 29, 2018**

**EVIDENTIARY HEARING TO PREHEARING CONFERENCE**

AND NOW, Complainant, HFT Holdings, by and through its attorneys Craig E. Maravich, Esq., Brad N. Sommer, Esq., and Sommer Law Group, P.C., files this Written Request for Conversion of January 29, 2019 Evidentiary Hearing to Prehearing Conference.

1. Pursuant to the Interim Order on the Motion to Consolidate and Preliminary Objections dated December 18, 2018, the parties were directed to confer and file a written request for conversion of the January 29, 2019 evidentiary hearing to a prehearing conference.
2. The parties have discussed this and it was suggested that Complainant HFT Holdings, Inc., file the written request and that Duquesne Light would not object.
3. Presently, the parties are engaged in discovery and settlement discussions.
4. Additionally, the attorney office representing Complainant had two attorneys unexpectedly leave in the last two weeks and is trying to fill the void left from their unexpected absence.
5. Currently, Complainant is working on supplying additional responses to discovery.

6. Additionally, Complainant is awaiting additional bills and invoices from Duquesne Light which the Complainant cannot access online.
7. This additional information is required for review by Complainant's expert.
8. Presently, undersigned counsel has scheduling conflict for January 29, 2019.
9. The parties have scheduled a settlement conference for January 28, 2019.
10. This request is not designed to prejudice any party nor is it objected to by Duquesne Light.
