RE: Agreement of Wastewater Collection System Sale, Jacobus Borough Sewer Authority and The York Water Company

Dear Mrs. Fowler:

I wish to inform you that The York Water Company ("York Water") has reached agreement with Jacobus Borough Sewer Authority ("Authority") to acquire the Authority's Wastewater Collection System. York Water will soon make application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission for a Certificate of Public Convenience authorizing York Water to serve the wastewater needs in Jacobus Borough.

York Water is aware of and familiar with the 1995 Agreement between Springfield Township and the Authority and the Springfield Township, York County, Sewer Authority's succession to the Agreement. The Authority intends to assign the agreement to York Water effective with closing on the Wastewater Collection System Sales Agreement. York Water and the Authority are working together to put the necessary closing conditions in place. Subject to the Commission's approval, we anticipate closing o/a September 1, 2019.

I understand there is a monthly meeting of the STYCSA and would appreciate the opportunity to join you and the authority members at a future meeting so that I may introduce myself and answer any questions they may have. I also understand there may be a periodic meeting (User Meeting) of the Connected Municipalities and would appreciate the opportunity to join one of those meetings to similarly answer their questions. I'm also available to meet with the Springfield Township Board of Supervisors should they have any questions.

In order to affect a seamless transition between the Authority and York Water, I would appreciate the opportunity to meet with you to discuss any issues or concerns you may have related to invoicing or the conditions prescribed in the 1995 Agreement. I'm available at your convenience.

York Water's intent is to file our application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission by December 1, 2018 with public notification through the Pennsylvania Bulletin and local newspaper concurrent with our filing. Recent experience with the PUC

suggests it may take 6 months for them to review the application. For planning purposes, I anticipate approval from the PUC in summer 2019 with initiation of wastewater service for Jacobus Borough o/a October 1, 2019.

I look forward to working with you, the members of the STYCSA and representatives for the other municipalities connected to the STYCSA collection and treatment works. The Springfield Township, York County, Sewer Authority (STYCSA) is in receipt of your letter dated October 25, 2018 and is aware of York Water's Agreement of Sale and intent to acquire the wastewater collection assets of the Jacobus Borough Sewer Authority. STYCSA acknowledges and agrees that subject to successfully closing on this sale, The York Water Company will succeed Jacobus Borough Sewer Authority as party to the 1995 Agreement between STYCSA and Jacobus Borough Sewer Authority and shall be subject to all of the obligations and shall be entitled to receive all of the rights and benefits of the 1995 Agreement.

The succession shall be contingent, however, upon the parties signing a mutually acceptable Assignment to the Sewage Capital Contribution and Treatment Agreement, which Assignment should be negotiated prior to your closing and must be executed as of the closing, to allow The York Water Company to succeed the Jacobus Borough Sewer Authority.

We discussed this matter at our recent meeting on November 21, 2018. Should you have questions or comments, please let us know. Thank you for your communication to date and anticipated cooperation. We look forward to working with you.
