**To Whom It May concern:**

**I have known Dorene since 1999 when she first contacted me regarding her medical problems. In 2002 I first saw her in person and evaluated her situation.**


**In view of the above she has become disabled and can survive only when accommodated for her extreme sensitivities.**

**INTERIM ORDER  
ESTABLISHING INITIAL LITIGATION SCHEDULE**

The Parties shall hereby comply with the following initial litigation schedule:

1. **ON OR BEFORE January 4, 2019**, any Party wishing to present factual testimony of any person other than Complainant must provide to the other Party in writing, the name and business address of that person and a written summary of the expected testimony of that person.
  
2. **ON OR BEFORE January 4, 2019**, any Party wishing to present expert testimony (including but not limited to medical, technical, etc.) must provide to the other Party in writing, the name and business address of that expert and a written summary of the expected testimony of that expert.
  
3. **ON OR BEFORE February 25, 2019**, the Parties shall conclude discovery in this proceeding.
  
4. **ON OR BEFORE March 5, 2019**, the Parties shall file a status report in this proceeding and serve the opposing Party and the undersigned Presiding Officer.
